


Meet your professional English-speaking guide by the ship and transfer by bus to the Old Town of Tallinn. Start a relaxed walk in the Old Town of Tallinn, which is divided into the **Upper Town and the Lower Town**. Located only within a 5 minute drive from the pier, the Old Town will surely capture your attention with a variety of medieval sights.

As you drive, you will be greeted by the Fat Margaret Tower and the Great Coastal Gate, you will then drive along the the city wall with defense towers. Once in the Upper Town, you will start your walking tour there.

Merchant houses, St Olaf's church, one of the oldest functioning pharmacies in the world, Alexander Nevsky Cathedral, The Three Sisters House, which is today a modern five-star hotel with a medieval charm – everything about the Old Town will mesmerize you and amaze you with it's perfectly preserved condition, like from a fairy tale. You will stroll through the narrow cobblestone lanes to the Dome Church (Virgin Mary Cathedral) and admire the magnificent panoramic views from Toompea Hill.

This tour being not just a historical overview of the days past, you will also learn about life of modern Estonians, see where they walk, shop and enjoy their coffee breaks!

Your guided tour will finish in the center of the Old Town and the guide will specify the meeting place for transfer back to the ship in 2 hrs. You will have 2 hrs of free time to continue your exploration independently. Just don't forget to come back to the meeting point for the transfer to the ship. It's so easy to lose track of time in this charming medieval place.

If you wish, to can stay in Old Town longer and either walk back to the ship or take a taxi there.

Meet your professional English-speaking guide and driver by the ship and depart for a scenic drive through the downtown of Helsinki. Just a couple of minutes from the pier, Market Square will surely not leave you indifferent. As you travel along Esplanadi **Street**, down famous **Mannerheim street**, which is the main boulevard, and past the Central Train Station make sure you keep your eyes wide open in order not to miss this beauty! You will later drive past such must-see sights like Uspensky cathedral, Presidential Palace, National Museum and Finlandia Hall, Opera House, Finlandia Concert Hall and Parlament Building.

You will drive past the Olympic Stadium (1952 Olympic games were held here), will have a chance to make great typically Helsinki photos in the Sibelius Park, a famous Helsinki sight, next to the Sibelius Monument constructed from hundreds of steel pipes honoring the great Finnish composer lan Sibelius.

Your tour will not be complete without seeing the Rock Church, from inside and out. This unique construction is a highlight for most visitors to Helsinki and is considered to be one of the Europe's most interesting churches. It was carved out of solid rock from the side of a mountain and is topped by a copper dome. The interior was excavated and built into the rock but is bathed in natural light entering through the glazed dome. The church is used frequently as a concert venue due to its excellent acoustic. The acoustic quality is ensured by the rough rock surfaces.

At the end of your guided tour, you will have an opportunity either to stay in the city center for lunch and shopping or to return back to the ship.

After a scenic ride of about 3 hours through the idyllic flatlands of North Germany with its hundreds of lakes, you will be met in the former West Berlin by your private guide, who will lead you to the highlights of the German capital.

You'll start with **Charlottenburg Castle** (Photo Stop) a splendid baroque palace dating from 1695. Your will then continue to the **Reichstag**, the German Parliament (Photo Stop) and the **Brandenburg Gate** (Photo Stop). Along the way you'll see, among other sites, the **Berlin Cathedral**, **the tree-lined "Unter den Linden" boulevard**, **the Museum Island**, **Bellevue Palace**, **Victory Column**, **the Kaiser Wilhelm Memorial Church** and of course some notorious sights of the **Third Reich and Cold War**, such as **Hermann Göring's Aviation Ministry** and the former site of **Hitler's Bunker**. Marvel at **Potsdamer Platz**, the place where modern architecture and lively metropolitan ambience meet Berlin history.

The group will be given time for a typical hearty Berlin lunch (not included in the tour price).

Take a unique picture of one of the only remaining stretches of the **Berlin Wall** (Photo Stop) and walk through the former **Checkpoint Charlie** (Photo Stop and time for souvenir shopping). Other highlights of the former East Berlin will include the **Alexanderplatz Square**, **Red City Hall and the Humbold University**. Before heading back to Warnemunde you will drive along popular **Kurfurstendamm Avenue**, **Berlins Champs Elysees**.

Meet your guide and driver by the ship. Start your City Tour. Stockholm has during the centuries transformed from a fortress to a town, from a town to a city and is today the capital of Sweden, some say, the capital of Scandinavia, but we will let you decide on that.

Our first stop is at the most popular viewpoint, from where we have a splendid panoramic view of the city, overlooking a few of the 14 islands, which Stockholm is founded upon, the Old Town as well as the Vasa Museum and City Hall.

The Vasa Museum is located on an island referred to as Royal Djurgården. It is the Stockholmers most beloved recreational area and home to the city's amusement park, the open-air museum Skansen, the playhouse of Astrid Lindgren "Junibacken" and much much more. The Vasa Museum displays the Swedish warship Vasa, which could be considered Sweden's greatest failure but is today instead one of the greatest success stories. Vasa sank on her maiden voyage, in Stockholm's inner harbour, in 1628. After 333 years at the bottom of the sea the Vasa was salvaged and stands before us 95% intact.

The City Hall is renowned for its architecture, the Blue Hall and the Golden Hall, and for being the site of the Nobel Prize Banquet. As we wonder through this very important building, fun and interesting facts like why it took 12 years to complete and who was the most important man throughout the construction are revealed.



The Kremlin was once a fortress before becoming the residence of the Russian tsars. After the Revolution of 1917 the USSR Government moved in it. Now it is the seat of the Russian President and a unique cultural museum complex composed of palaces, cathedrals and museums.

We will tour the grounds of the Kremlin and visit its cathedrals striking architecture, ancient frescoes and icons: Assumption Cathedral where Russian tsars and emperors were crowned; Archangel Cathedral - the burial vault of the Russian tsars until 18th centuries; and Annunciation Cathedral, a home church for the royalty. You will get to meet the 2 prominent Russian tsars in person: the Tsar Bell and the Tsar Cannon, the biggest in the world. While touring the Kremlin we also visit the Armoury museum and the Diamond Fund.

The Armoury museum is famous for the Tsar's regalia such as jeweled crowns, orbs and scepters, clothing of the Russian tsars and tsarinas, royal carriages, collection of arms and armour, gifts to the Russian Tsars from various countries of the West and the East, and the illustrious collection of Faberge Easter eggs.

The Diamond Fund is an exceptional exhibition of precious stones, gold and platinum nuggets, and crown jewels of the Russian tsars.

The Kremlin is sure to reveal you some mysteries of the Russian state and soul.

A Walk in the Historical Center of the city

Almost every building in the historical center of Moscow is associated with different events and celebrated personalities of the Russian history and culture. You will see and hear the stories of the most popular places of the city:

- Red Square, the hub of Russia, with its fantastic "stone flower"- St. Basil's Cathedral, one of the symbols of Moscow;
- Fancy Manezhnaya Square with the Zero Kilometer, a starting point for all Moscow roads;
- Alexander's Garden with the eternal flame, a Second World War memorial, where you might watch a change of guards;
- A walk along Arbat Street, a colorful promenade with numerous souvenir stalls, antique stores, cafes, street musicians and painters.





This two-hour arrangement covers the city districts of **Södermalm**, **Gamla Stan**, **Norrmalm**, **Östermalm**, **and Djurgården**, each with its own special character. Crossing **Gamla Stan**, the enchanting, medieval **Old Town** we pass **the Royal Palace** over-looking Stockholm's inner harbour. We proceed past **the Royal Dramatic Theatre along Strandvägen to the island of Djurgården**, better known as the outdoor recreation center for the city locals. As we tour the island of Djurgården we pass the **Gröna Lund Tivoli and Skansen open-air museum**.

Our tour continues through **the Diplomatic Town to Östermalm** – the city's most fashionable neighborhood with stately apartment buildings to **Sergels Torg**, the focal point of modern Stockholm. In the distance we will see the three crowns atop the imposing **City Hall**. Passing this impressive building, renowned for its architecture, murals, mosaics and as the site of the Nobel Prize Banquet, we'll learn more about the life of **Alfred Nobel**. We will then proceed south via the Western Bridge to Södermalm, the largest out of the 14 islands, which Stockholm is founded upon. Stockholm's south side contains a number of small closely integrated neighborhoods. Our tour ends with a short stop at Fjällgatan for a splendid panoramic view of the city. Return back to the ship.

Right in the heart of the city is where the world's first permanent **Absolute ice bar** is located. The entire interior including glasses is made of pure clear ice from the Torne River in Northern Sweden and the temperature is kept at below zero, around -5° C year-round. Provided with a warm fur poncho and mittens before entering the bar, enjoy a vodka drink in an ice glass as the staff tells you more about this ice-cold experience. Entrance to the Ice Bar is included.

Once we are nice and cool we will proceed through the city, in two hours we will cover the districts of **Södermalm**, the largest out of the 14 islands, which Stockholm is founded upon. **Gamla Stan**, the enchanting, medieval **Old Town** where everything once began. **Östermalm**, known as the more exclusive part of town and great for fashionable shopping. **Djurgården**, where the locals come to enjoy the greenery and visit the many museums located in the island. Each of the islands has its own special character. Return back to the ship.

Meet your guide and driver by the ship. Start your City Tour. Stockholm has during the centuries transformed from a fortress to a town, from a town to a city and is today the capital of Sweden, some say, the capital of Scandinavia, but we will let you decide on that.

Our first stop is at **the most popular viewpoint**, from where we have a splendid panoramic view of the city. Overlooking a few of the 14 islands, which Stockholm is founded upon, the Old Town as well as the Vasa Museum and City Hall.

The Vasa Museum is located on an island referred to as Royal Djurgården. It is the Stockholmers most beloved recreational area and home to the city's amusement park, the open-air museum Skansen, the playhouse of Astrid Lindgren "Junibacken" and much much more. The Vasa Museum displays the Swedish warship Vasa, which could be considered Sweden's greatest failure but is today instead one of the greatest success stories. Vasa sank on her maiden voyage in Stockholm's inner harbour in 1628. After 333 years at the bottom of the sea the Vasa was salvaged and stands before us 95% intact.

The City Hall is renowned for its architecture, **the Blue Hall and Golden Hall**, and for being the site of the Nobel Prize Banquet. As we wander through this very important building, fun and interesting facts like why it took 12 years to complete, and who was the most important man throughout the construction are revealed. Return back to the ship.

The museum is situated in **the Old Town**, where a stroll through narrow alleys and over cobbled streets taking in the medieval atmosphere is also included.

A brief coach ride through the city centre, passing among others **the Concert Hall**, also important for the Nobel Festivities, takes us to **the City Hall**. At the City Hall, the venue of **the Nobel Banquet**, we will learn more about the building with its fabulous **Blue Hall and Golden Hall**. What does the national Swedish symbol of the Three Crowns represent? How do you walk down a staircase with 1300 guests looking at you? And how does the Nobel Banquet come together? This and much more will be revealed on our tour. Return back to the ship.

Day 1

Day 3

10:00 Start your day with a walk in the historical centre of the city with a visit to Lenin's Mausoleum, St Basil Cathedral and shopping mall GUM.

Almost every building in the historical center of Moscow is associated with different events and celebrated personalities of the Russian history and culture. You will see and hear the stories of the most popular places of the city:

- **Red Square**, the hub of Russia, with its fantastic "stone flower"- St. Basil's Cathedral, one of the symbols of Moscow
- Fancy Manezhnaya Square with the Zero Kilometer, a starting point for all Moscow roads
- **Alexander's Garden** with the eternal flame, a Second World War memorial, where you might watch a change of guards
- The Armoury
- St. Basil's Cathedral
- Lenin's Mauseoleum
- GUM
- Arbat Street
- Moscow metro
- Izmailovo crafts market

These are places that make Moscow one of the most beautiful cities in Russia.

Enjoy a delicious lunch in one of the multiple downtown cafes or restaurants and continue the day with a **tour of the Kremlin and the Armoury museum**.

The Kremlin was once a fortress before becoming the residence of the Russian tsars. After the Revolution of 1917 the USSR Government moved in it. Now it is the seat of the Russian President and a unique cultural museum complex composed of palaces, cathedrals and museums. You will tour the grounds of the Kremlin and visit its cathedrals with striking architecture, ancient frescoes and icons: Assumption Cathedral where Russian tsars and emperors were crowned; Archangel Cathedral - the burial vault of the Russian tsars until the 18th century; and Annunciation Cathedral, a home church for the royalty. You will get to meet the 2 prominent Russian tsars in person: the Tsar Bell and the Tsar Cannon, the biggest in the world. Kremlin is sure to reveal you some mysteries of the Russian state and soul!

While touring the Kremlin you will also visit the **Armoury museum**, famous for the Tsar's regalia such as jeweled crowns, orbs and scepters, clothing of the Russian tsars and tsarinas, royal carriages, collection of arms and armour, gifts to the Russian Tsars from various countries of the West and the East, and the illustrious collection of Faberge Easter eggs.

The tour continues with a walk along **Arbat Street**, a colorful promenade with numerous souvenir stalls, antique stores, cafes, street musicians and painters. You will take **Metro** to go back to the hotel and have a short **Metro tour** on the way to see some of the most beautiful stations of world famous Moscow subway system.

Evening Transfer to the train station to **catch Fast Sapsan Train to St.Petersburg**. **Enjoy the luxury** of this speedy ride and keep your eyes open for the marvellous St.Petersburg at night.

Enjoy a private guided tour of the Hermitage museum and ask as many questions as you can think of while exploring the enormous collections. During the tour you will see state palace interiors of the Winter Palace, the most glorious tzar residence in Russia, started by Empress Elizabeth I and finished under Catherine the Great's rule. Explore magnificent art collections assembled by the Imperial family and carefully saved from destruction by the staff of the museum during the Second World War. You will see the highlights of the 15th-18th century European Art collection like **Da Vinci, Michaelangelo, Raphael, Veronese, Tintoretto, Tiepolo** and other world-famous names, as well as enjoy the museum's collection of Impressionists and Post-Impressionists.

Port Security Measures/Customs - The Port and Customs Authority requires all passengers to provide their name exactly as it appears on the passport, passport number, their date of birth and gender, as well as Citizenship.

Membership and Health - Membership will be granted to all persons. Please consult your physician for pre-departure health advice. ULKOtours reserves the right to terminate the tour of any persons who are abusive of others or whose behaviour disrupts the tour. Easy Tours are suitable for persons that require assistance or the use a wheelchair.
