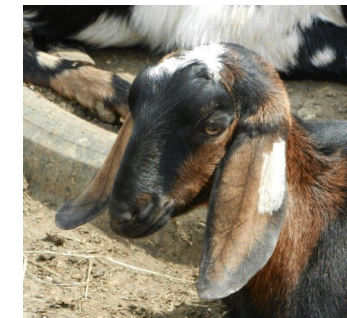

Goats

Our goats are mainly Pygmies and Anglo Nubian. The Pygmy is the smallest (and often chubbiest) goat, very hardy and curious. The Anglo Nubian is by contrast the largest goat and requires good nutritional maintenance and feels the cold. They are distinctive for their long silky ears and aristocratic Roman noses.



Herdwick Sheep

Herdwicks are a breed of sheep originating from the Lake District in Cumbria and are one of the oldest breeds in the UK. Beatrix Potter kept them and they are gentle, good mothers outwintering easily on the fells because of their thick coarse coats. Lambs are born completely black, and only gradually grow the white wool that is so distinctive in the adults.
