The Kautz

Crystalline Gold Specimen

Is the rarest form and the largest single piece of gold mined in North America since the 1880s, weighing in at **44 pounds**. On December 26, 1992, owners of the Sonora Mining Corporation mine near Jamestown, Tuolumne County, received an unexpected Christmas present. Excavations in the company's crystalline mine uncovered a pocket of crystalline gold leaf. The Kautz specimen is unique in that it is not only the largest mass of gold specimen found in California since the turn of the century; it is the largest in existence today.
