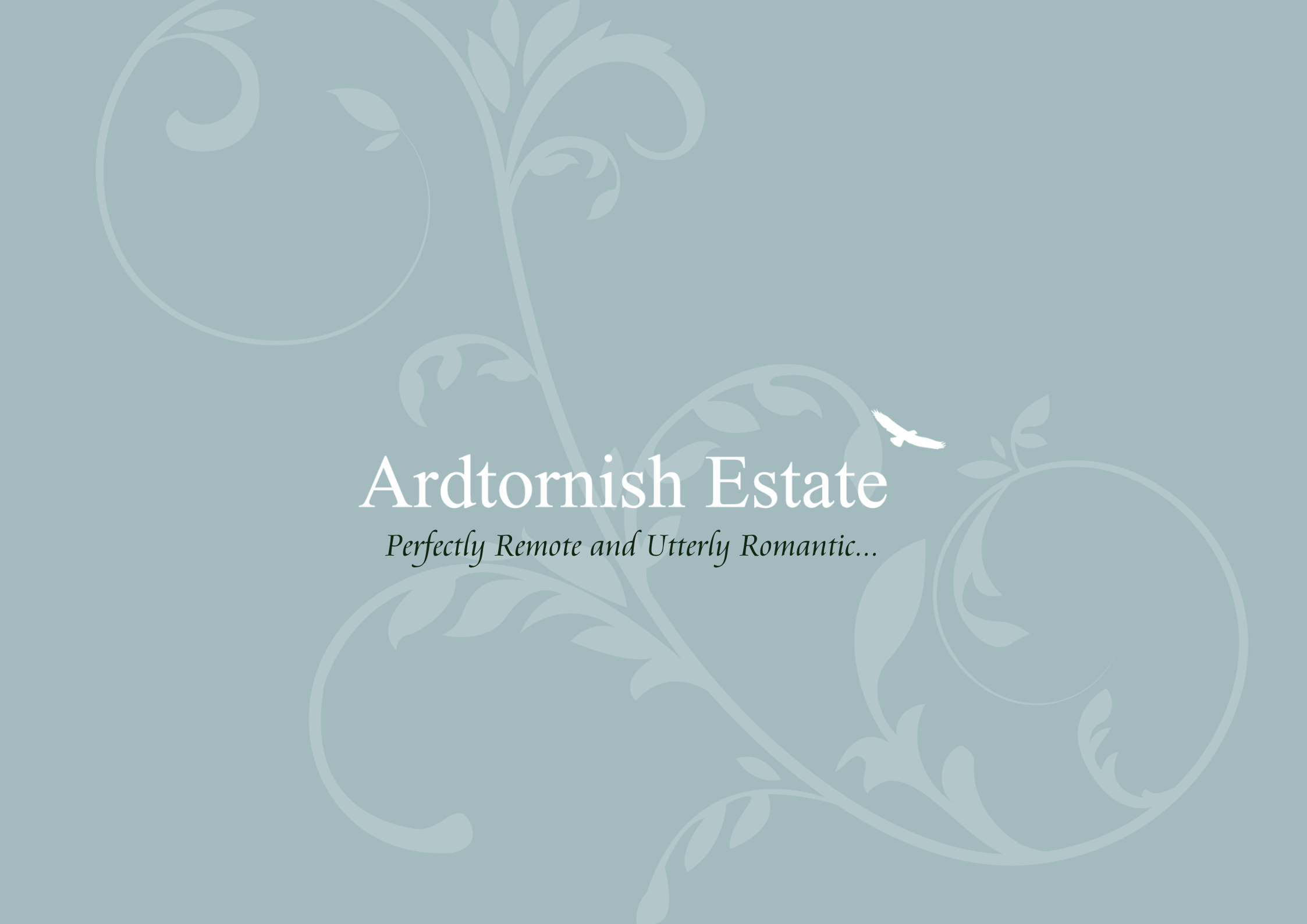

If outdoors is your preference, our gardens provide open spaces with opportunities for marquees which will have beautiful backdrops of woodlands, mountains and loch.

Accommodation

Ardtornish Estate is one of a unique selection of exclusive use venues in Scotland. Accommodation is available within the estate for up to 120 guests in a variety of spacious Victorian apartments and traditional stone-built cottages.

Ardtornish House

Ardtornish House is a Grade A listed Victorian building with high ceilings and many attractive architectural features. With generous picture-windows and large open fires, the house embraces its Victorian grandeur. It has been sensitively divided into five equally unique and spacious apartments accommodating up to 46 of your closest family and friends. The grand features and enormous proportions of the South Wing become 'home' for the bridal party with a four poster bedroom suite that doesn't disappoint.

Retaining many of the original features, the house never fails to impress and has bathrooms including traditional roll-top baths with Victorian fittings. There is even a sauna and a fully operational luggage lift to transport bags to the upstairs apartments with ease. Guests can relax in the comfortable surroundings of unique style and original features whilst enjoying attractive views over the peaceful gardens and grounds. Making this their home, guests can feel free to explore the house and grounds and enjoy anything from a quiet game of snooker in the Billiard Room to a bracing dip in the loch!

Self-Catering Cottages

Within the estate there are six additional self-catering cottages. Each of these stone-built properties is unique in style and size. They have cosy wood burning stoves and boast either loch or riverside locations and views. We also have a bunkhouse which can accommodate up to 17 guests.

Many wedding guests are happy to walk the short distance to the main house for the wedding. However, it is possible to arrange transport for guests as required.

Our estate cottages provide accommodation for a further 57 guests bringing the total accommodation numbers to 120.
