High Ropes Course & AquaDrop Requirements:

- All participants must complete the waiver form and emergency contact form prior to being allowed on the course. A Parent or legal Guardian must sign the form for children under the age of 18. Forms are available on our website.
- Secure closed toe shoes must be worn
- Participants' Min. weight – 20 Kg (45 lbs)/ Max. weight 120 Kg (265 lbs)
- Participants' minimum height is 127 cm (50") regardless of age
- Minimum age is 8 years old. Children under the age of 12 must be accompanied on the Ropes Course by an adult (18 yrs or over)

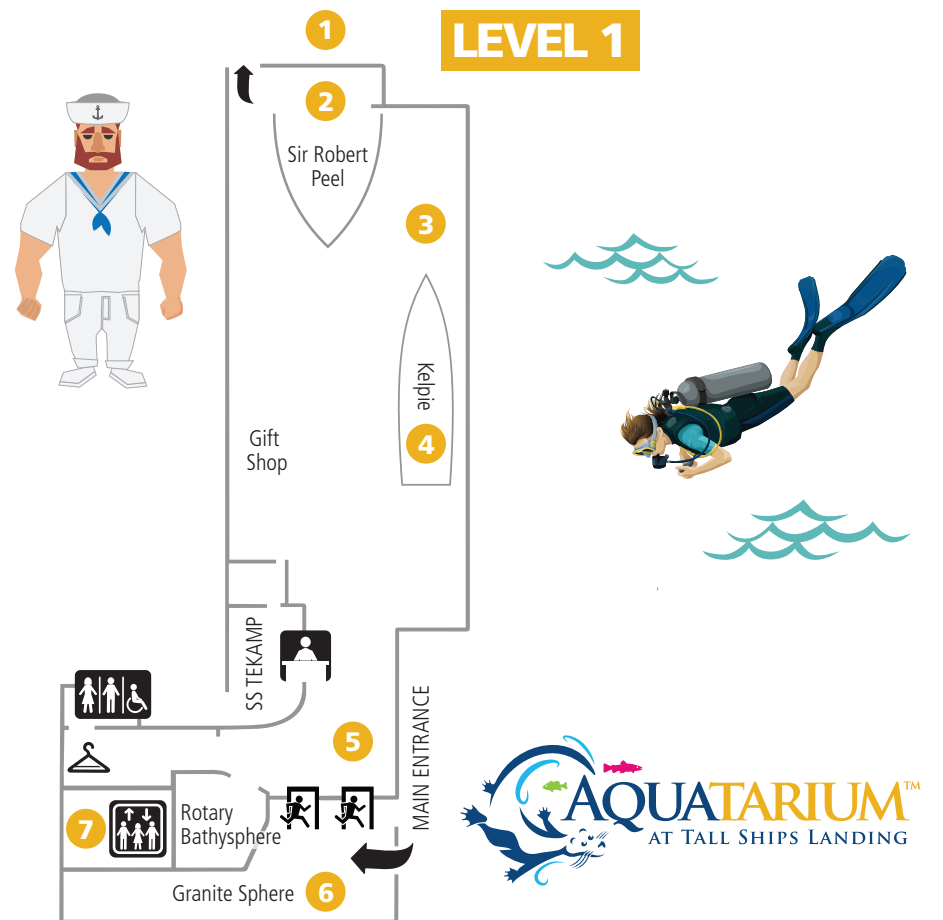
- CREATION** – Touch Tank – Discover a world from more than 10,000 years ago, right in our own backyard!

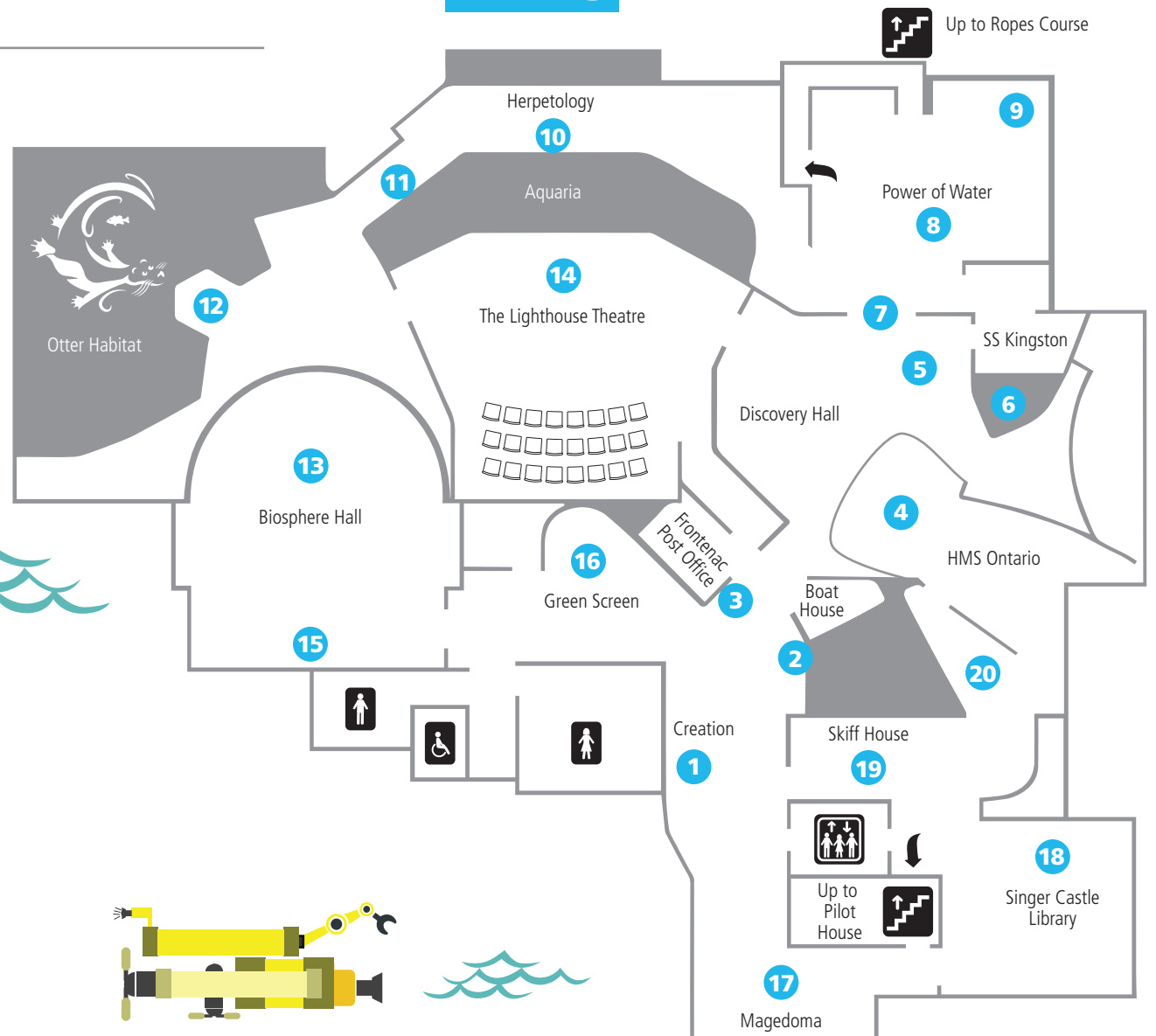
- PILOT HOUSE** – Enjoy the spectacular view, practice your navigational skills at our boat simulator or learn about the solar system in our planetarium presentations.
