The Golden Circle refers to a popular route that covers some of Iceland's most stunning sights. It takes in three striking sights within 130 km of our capital city.

Þingvellir National Park

A UNESCO world heritage site important in terms of history, culture and geology. Iceland's largest lake and the site of the Alþingi assembly - the world's oldest parliament.

Hot springs at Geysir geothermal area

Be prepared for the Strokkur hot spring, the world's most reliable geyser, shooting hot water 20 metres into the air every 4-8 minutes.

Gullfoss waterfall

This is Iceland's most famous waterfall. It drops a whopping 32 metres and, as you can imagine, creates guite a lot of spray that forms beautiful rainbows during sunny days.
















GOLDEN CIRCLE CLASSIC

Discover Iceland's most iconic natural and historical attractions on this all-time best-selling tour.

Explore Þingvellir National Park, arguably the most important site in Iceland in terms of history, culture, and geology. A UNESCO World Heritage Site, Pingvellir National Park is home to Iceland's largest natural lake and the place where the tectonic plates of North America and Eurasia split and drift apart.

At Gullfoss waterfall you can take a short walk down a pathway, get right up close to this powerful waterfall and feel the mist of glacial water on your face.

The Geysir geothermal area is home to the geyser after which all others are named, as well as the Strokkur hot spring, which blasts out water every few minutes up to 20 metres into the air.

GOLDEN CIRCLE & FONTANA GEOTHERMAL BATHS

Explore Iceland's most popular landmarks on the Golden Circle Tour and enjoy a relaxing visit to the natural Icelandic steam baths at Laugarvatn Fontana Geothermal Baths.

On this Golden Circle Tour you will visit Þingvellir National Park, Laugarvatn Fontana, Gullfoss waterfall and Geysir geothermal area.

For almost a century, locals in the community of Laugarvatn have been enjoying the healing powers of natural steam from a geothermal field at the edge of the lake. Built over this geothermal area, Laugarvatn Fontana features geothermal steam rooms, hot pools and outdoor mineral baths, and a fantastic view over the lake.

From Laugarvatn the tour takes you to Gullfoss waterfall where you can get up close and feel the mist of glacial water on your face as it cascades down into the narrow Hvítárgljúfur canyon.

Heading back, you'll visit the Geysir geothermal area, and stand next to an erupting geyser.

At Pingvellir National Park you can take in the view over lake Pingvallavatn, Iceland's largest natural lake, and explore the place where the tectonic plates of North America and Eurasia split and drift apart.

From Pingvellir you'll continue to the iconic waterfall, Gullfoss, where glacial meltwater cascades down into the deep and narrow Hvítárgljúfur canyon.

Returning from Gullfoss, next stop is the Geysir geothermal area, where you'll get to walk amidst hissing steam vents and sulphurous mud pots, and get up close to an erupting geyser.

The nearby Friðheimar is a family venture powered by green energy, and proud suppliers of the sweetest tomatoes, chutneys and jams. The tasting continues at Íslenski Bærinn's "turf-house" kitchen, when it's time to taste some traditional Icelandic delicacies.

DELICIOUS WEST COAST FOOD TOUR - By minibus

Journey into a wonderland of delicious Icelandic food and beer tasting while exploring the beautiful region North-West of Reykjavík.

At the Háafell goat farm we will try delicious goat cheese and learn all there is about the Icelandic goat.

The tour continues to Brúarás Geocenter where we will have lunch before going to the picturesque Hraunfossar waterfalls; a series of waterfalls formed by rivulets streaming out of a lava field.

Then it is time to visit Steðji micro-brewery for some beer tasting. Steðji brewery is named after a rock formation in front of the place and means "Anvil."

After tasting the delicious beer at Steðji we will visit the Bjarteyjarsandur family farm to try out some local food. The farm emphasises high quality products made in an environmentally sustainable way.

From Bjarteyjarsandur farm we will drive around the beautiful Hvalfjörður (Whale Fjord) on our way back to Reykjavík.

This tour combines food and beer tasting with the locals as well as taking you through areas often missed when exploring Iceland.

REYKJAVÍK CITY SIGHTSEEING - By minibus

This tour covers the city's top attractions, interesting facts and stories. It provides an excellent opportunity to discover various things to see or do in Reykjavík during your stay in Iceland.

On this tour you will see the The old Höfði house where the all-important summit between the leaders Ronald Reagan and Mikhail Gorbachev took place in 1986. Höfði house is also believed to be haunted by a ghost known as the The White Ladv.

The tour proceeds to the the Harpa concert hall and conference centre which was the 2013 winner of the European Union Prize for Contemporary Architecture – Mies van der Rohe Award.

From the City Hall in the city centre we will take a short walk over to the Parliament House which was built in 1880-1881 and made out of dolerite from the area. You will see Hallgrímskirkja church, whose design was inspired by basalt lava columns – a common volcanic rock formation in Icelandic nature.

We will visit the viewing platform at Perlan glass dome which provides a 360° view over Reykjavík. After enjoying the view over Reykjavík from Perlan you will see Bessastaðir the official residence of the President of Iceland.

MOVIE & MUSIC TOUR

From Star Wars to Justin Bieber - a visit to some of the locations used in recent years to shoot films and music videos in Iceland.

This tour will take you to some of the most beautiful places on the south coast of Iceland. What they all have in common is that they became even better known when used by film makers and musicians for their projects. You will visit the haunted mountain Hjörleifshöfði where Rogue One: A Star Wars Story (2016) was partly filmed.

Skógafoss waterfall was used in sequences set in the mythical home of the gods, Asgard in the film Thor 2: The Dark World (2013). The Secret Life of Walter Mitty (2013) and Dilwale (2015) were also partly shot here.

The abandoned US Navy plane wreck at the black sands of Sólheimasandur is one of those must-visit places. The plane appeared in Justin Bieber's music video "I'll show you."

Reynisfjara beach is often referred to as the most impressive beach in Iceland. The last scenes of Noah (2014) were filmed here. It was also used for shots in Star Trek: Into Darkness (2013).

During the "Movie & Music Tour" you will visit places that may look familiar to you. You might want to watch some of your favorite films all over after having been on this tour.





On the way to the cave we will visit the most powerful hot spring in Europe, Deildartunguhver, and the picturesque Hraunfossar waterfalls; a series of waterfalls formed by rivulets streaming out of a lava field.

Víðgelmir lava tunnel is known by many Icelanders as the greatest cave in Iceland.

With the aid of a walkway and feature lights the stunning, enormous beauty can now be enjoyed with comfort and ease, enhanced only by the expert cave guides.

After the cave visit, we will visit the geothermal pool in Húsafell where you can the relax in the warm water.

Come and experience the most spectacular lava tube Iceland has to offer.

INSIDE THE GLACIER

Waterfalls, hot springs & Langjökull Ice Cave

An exclusive, once-in-a-lifetime adventure to Iceland's most significant new attraction: the man-made Ice Cave in Langjökull glacier.

On this tour we visit the most powerful hot spring in Europe, Deildartunguhver, and the picturesque Hraunfossar waterfalls; a series of waterfalls formed by rivulets streaming out of a lava field.

From Borgarfjörður the tour continues to Langjökull glacier where you will ride in a specialised 8-wheel-drive truck to the glacier cap and experience the hidden and beautiful blue hues at the heart of the icy mass. As you walk further along the tunnel, the ice gets older and its colour gradually changes from white to deep-blue. Making your way inside the glacier you'll be able to explore various chambers and walk over a huge ice crevasse on a specially constructed bridge.

A complimentary visit to the thermal pool in Húsafell is a perfect ending to this journey of Ice Caves. Please note that a visit to the swimming pool might not be possible due to delays in passengers returning from the glacier.

WATERFALLS, GLACIER & VOLCANO

- See the view from the top of Mt. Eyjafjallajökull

This tour combines a visit to waterfalls, a glacier and a volcano: a trio sometimes said to be kind of a trademark for what can be seen in Iceland.

We will start by driving to a viewpoint on the edge of Mt. Hellisheiði east of Reykjavík before we take a look at Urriðafoss waterfall, located in a glacial river called Þjórsá.

Further east we will stop to explore the area surrounding the waterfalls Seljalandsfoss and Gljúfrabúi; the former being the one you can walk behind.

Gígjökull is one of many outlet glaciers of the larger Eyjafjallajökull glacier. This is where part of the meltwater from the Eyjafjallajökull eruption in 2010 came down to the lowlands.

At this point we board a Super Truck and head up to Eyjafjallajökull glacier. The truck and Eyjafjallajökull have one thing in common; both are one of a kind.

This tour offers you an experience worth a spot on your bucket list.

LANDMANNALAUGAR PEARL OF THE HIGHLANDS

- Hiking & bathing tour

One of Iceland's most breathtaking and iconic landmarks.

Formed in a massive 15th century eruption, Landmannalaugar is a place of striking contrasts and exceptional natural beauty. Miles of mountains, canyons, and towering rocks in unique combinations of natural colour decorate the area.

The journey to Landmannalaugar takes you through the lush farmlands of southern Iceland and into the valley of Þjórsárdalur where you'll explore the picturesque Hjálparfoss waterfall and surroundings.

Arriving in Landmannalaugar, you can delight in the scenery, hike for around 2 hours into the multicoloured hills with your guide and enjoy a relaxing bath in a natural geothermal spring afterwards.

Heading back from Landmannalaugar across the harsh, but beautiful highland landscape you'll pass by the slopes of Mt. Hekla, one of Iceland's most infamous volcanoes.

SOUTH COAST & JÖKULSÁRLÓN **GLACIER LAGOON**

On this tour you will travel along Iceland's south coast on the narrow strip of lush farmland that cuts between mountains, glaciers and the vast Atlantic ocean.

The route is lined with natural treasures including the iconic Selialandsfoss and Skógafoss waterfalls, Skaftafell National Park, and Vatnajökull glacier to name but a few.

Passing the southern edge of the mighty Vatnajökull glacier roughly midway between Reykjavík and Jökulsárlón glacier lagoon, Skaftafell National Park offers magnificent views of glaciers, rivers and endless plains of sand. Skaftafell is a part of Vatnajökull glacier National Park, which stretches over an area of 14,000 square km, or roughly 10 times the size of London. When you think nothing can beat the scenery, Jökulsárlón glacier lagoon opens up before your eyes and takes your breath away. Packed with icebergs in various shades of white and blue, the lagoon's extraordinary scenery is popular with travellers, photographers and filmmakers from all over the world.

Specialized amphibious vehicles take visitors out onto the lagoon, sailing among the enormous chunks of ice. Various bird species can be seen feeding in and around the lagoon and seals are a fairly common sight both at the mouth of the lagoon and at the seaside beach.

SOUTH COAST & WATERFALLS

Travel through the ever-changing landscape of south Iceland; a landscape truly shaped by the combination of glaciers and volcanos.

This tour takes you through the area that was covered with layers of ash from the Eyjafjallajökull eruption in 2010. We are talking about the eruption that caused disruption for many local people when they had to evacuate their home and all the travellers who found out that their flights were cancelled due to it.

Enjoy the rainbows at Skógafoss waterfall and learn about the legend of Prasi who was a settler said to have buried a chest of gold under the waterfall. You will get the chance to take a walk on the black sands of Reynisfjara beach with surrounding basalt columns, cliffs and a cave.

We will take you towards Sólheimajökull glacier with its little lagoon where small icebergs are usually seen floating around.

Seljalandsfoss waterfall is the one you can walk behind if you feel like it before we return to Reykjavík.

This tour combines visits to some of the most beautiful places on the south coast of Iceland.







Gray Line Iceland ("Gray Line" or "we", "our" or "us") is a tourism specialist, offering a comprehensive range of sight-seeing tours, day tours, vacation packages, tailor-made travel services, Airport Express, pick up and drop off services and/or other related services ("Services").

The Services are accessible and can be purchased by booking a reservation ("**Booking**"), through any of Gray Line's vendors ("**Vendo**r").

This brochure ("Brochure") sets forth the terms and conditions ("Terms & Conditions"), which you agree to comply with and be legally bound by when purchasing the Services by making a Booking through the Vendor.

The Terms & Conditions also involve that you are bound by the privacy policy of Gray Line ("**Privacy Policy**") and Gray Line's Easy Cancellation Policy ("**Cancellation Policy**") which both are set forth in the Brochure.

The Terms & Conditions as set forth in this Brochure shall govern your use of the Services in the following manner:

1. Confirmation of departure & duration

When you book the Services with the Vendor you will receive a voucher or an electronic voucher ("**Voucher**") stating departure times and the duration of the tours. The estimated duration of tours as indicated in the Voucher are standard times and can vary according to road or weather conditions.

2. Price:

Prices for the Services provided by Gray Line are in Icelandic kronas (ISK).

Customers paying full fares are allowed to have 2 children/youths to accompany them free of charge.

Payments

There is no charge and/or fee for processing credit card payments when the Services are purchased.

4. Cancellations & refunds

All cancellations shall be notified to the Vendor in writing or emailed to iceland@grayline.is. Most of the Services offered and sold by the Vendor are fully refundable when cancelled up to 24 hours prior to departure under the Cancellation Policy. The Cancellation Policy is noted on all applicable Services with a duration of 24 hours or less. Specific cancellation and refund policies are noted in the description details. Refunds may take up to 14 business days.

5. Place of departure

It is your responsibility to arrive in good time to check in for your tour at the place of departure as stipulated in the Voucher.




