### From the North

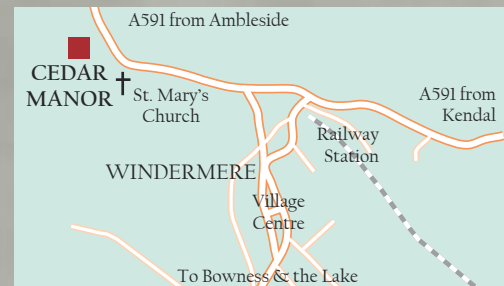
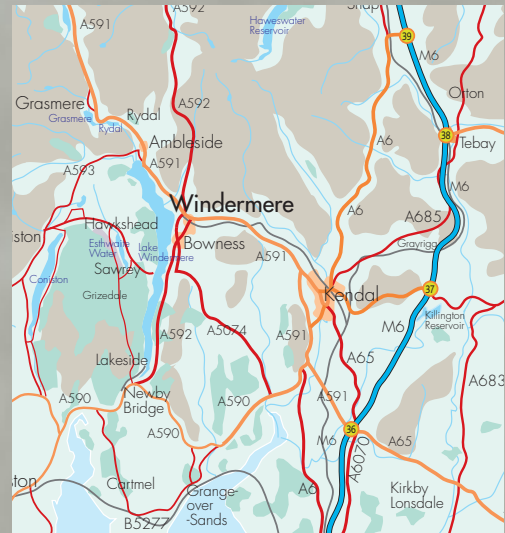
Leave the M6 at junction 39.

Take the one way system through the town following signs for Windermere and the A591.

### By Train

Change at Oxenholme (Kendal) to connect to the local train to Windermere station. Oxenholme to Windermere takes 15 minutes. Cedar Manor is a 10 minute walk down hill or a 1 minute taxi ride.
