ABOUT SANDWOOD LODGE



There are 38 log cabins on the site but only a few are let out including my one, so it is usually fairly quiet. Owners normally come up to their lodges on several weekends in the year.

All bed linen and towels are included as is gas and electricity.

The lodge sleeps six and is about 50 metres from the water. It is just 10 years old.

It has central heating throughout, two king size double bedrooms - one with en-suite shower and toilet, one twin bedded room and another spacious shower room and toilet. There is an open plan sitting room with two leather settees and a comfortable dining table with six chairs. The fully fitted kitchen has a full size fridge and freezer, dishwasher, all cutlery, crockery and utensils for six people. A washing machine and dryer is also provided.

There is a 42" digital flat screen TV, Freesat satellite channels, VHS video and a DVD player and a CD / Radio player.

Outside there is spacious wrap-around decking from which you can see Loch Lomond through the trees, with full size table, six chairs and parasol. A bar b g is also provided (bring charcoal).



SELF CATERING LOG CABIN LOCH LOMOND, SCOTLAND

Sandwood Lodge is a homely, privately owned log cabin which sleeps up to six. It is situated at Rowardennan, Loch Lomond in Scotland, in a striking setting on a quiet, private estate of log cabins.

Imagine clear starry nights, walks wrapped up against chilly and crisp bright winter days or long summer day trips away exploring Rob Roy country or the mountains of Argyll to the west or north to Oban and beyond - this can be all yours too.

Rowardennan, which is at the foot of Ben Lomond, is on the east shores of Loch Lomond and six miles north from the pretty loch side village of Balmaha. The private site on which the log cabins sit is right on the loch side and The Rowardennan Hotel is nearby.

This is the quieter side of Loch Lomond and an area famous for the West Highland Way taking walkers on beneath Ben Lomond nearby.

Loch Lomond is certainly one of the world's, and Scotland's, most stunning and internationally renowned locations at the southern end of the Scotlish Highlands. There's also direct access to the loch for water based sports and easy launching.

There is a jetty and shallow beach which is ideal for canoeing from or launching windsurfers and sailing boats. Moorings for speed boats can be hired from the Rowardennan Hotel.

There are plenty of grassy areas and the gently sloping beaches are ideal for paddling and a picnic.



You can spend a day in Edinburgh which is just over an hour and half's drive away. Stirling too is in easy reach in just 50 minutes. Both cities are famous for their historic castles, and much more besides.
