Hugging Auckland City is the breathtaking Hauraki Gulf Marine Park, one of the most biologically and geographically diverse marine parks in the world. Part of the Pacific Ocean, the area is visited by an astonishing one third of all

> marine-mammal species found on earth and is also home to the critically endangered Bryde's Whale. All of which make it a truly world class resource sitting right on Auckland's doorstep.

• More than 23 species of Whale and Dolphin have been spotted in the Gulf. Whale species include Bryde's,

Fin, Blue, Southern Right, Sei, False Killer Whales and Humpbacks.

• Dolphins always keep us entertained by playing on the bow wave. Species commonly spotted include the Common Dolphin, Bottlenose and Orca (which are actually part of the Dolphin family)

 See an amazing abundance and diversity of sea-birds including Australasian Gannets, Petrels, Shearwaters, Penguins, White Fronted Terns and many more.

• There's a wealth of other interesting sea life out on the Hauraki Gulf. Every trip is different but this can include Seals, Sharks, Rays and lots of different types of fish.
