If you are unable to visit us here in Herefordshire we are more than willing to deliver the Eastnor Pottery experience at a venue of your choice.



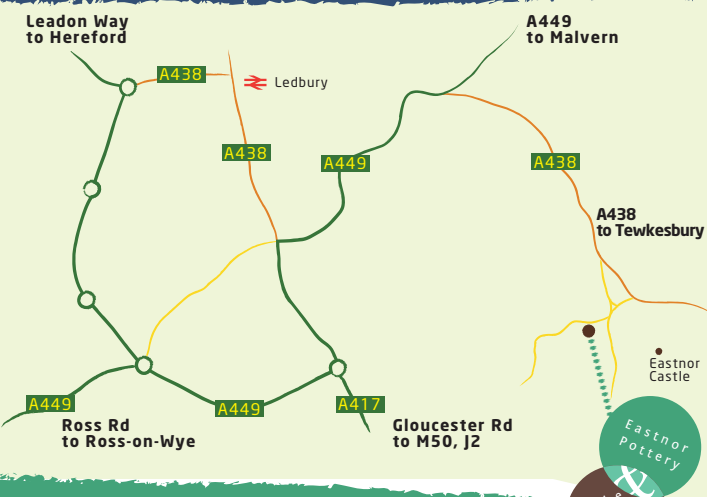
