

Thank you for your interest in Soaring® Tree Top Adventures!



Below are a few guidelines and suggestions for your day at Soaring:

Soaring is a high-energy, all-day zipline adventure. Guests fly on over 1.5 miles of networked cables through lush, old-growth Ponderosa and Aspen forest and over the Animas River. Guests arrive by historic train in a first class car, Soar across 27 different zipline spans, learn about the unique forest ecology, enjoy a gourmet lunch in the trees and return to Durango by train in the early evening.

Soaring has excited guests ages 3-94. Guests should weigh between 50 and 265 pounds. Moderate, uphill hiking is involved throughout the day.

ATTIRE:

REQUIRED: Shoes that FULLY enclose the foot (sneakers or hiking boots). Long hair should be tied back.

For comfort, please consider wearing the following:

- * Longer pants, as the harness leg loops around your thighs can ride up.
- * A shirt with a collar, as the harness shoulder straps may rub on your neck.
- * Short shorts and tank tops can be very uncomfortable.

You may want to bring/apply bug spray or sun lotion.

Soaring® operates rain or shine – consider bringing a rain jacket with hood and/or other attire to be outside in the elements during the day.

THINGS TO KNOW:

Smoking and alcohol is prohibited.

Anyone suspected to be under the influence of alcohol or illegal substances will be evicted without a refund.

Pocket-size cameras are allowed on the course and can be attached to your harness with a wrist strap.

Lockable lockers are available for storing your belongings.

Pregnant women may not participate in Soaring. Soaring is not wheelchair accessible.

TRAIN TIMES:

DURANGO DEPARTURE: 8:00 am. We are a ticketless travel, please check-in with the Soaring attendant outside the red ***Tall Timber Legend*** train car and be ready to board 30 minutes prior to departure.

ROCKWOOD DEPARTURE: 9:10 am. 878 County Road 200 Durango, CO 81301

Be parked and ready in Rockwood at the building marked "Rockwood Boarding Point" by 8:45 am. When the train arrives in Rockwood, check-in with the Soaring attendant then board the red "Tall Timber" train car.

Parking: Park your car in the public gravel lot on either side of the tracks.

ARRIVAL TO "SOARING®/TALL TIMBER": 9:54 am. Soaring® staff will greet you as you arrive on property.

RETURN TRAIN TIMES: Train departure from Soaring® is 3:24 pm. Arrival back to Rockwood is at 4:05 pm; arrival back to Durango is 5:15 pm.

MINORS:

Parents must sign for their children under 18 years of age. Grandparents or other guardians accompanying a minor must have an original signed waiver (can be printed off Soaring's® website or obtained at the train station's Group Ticket Office) from a parent plus a photocopy of that parent's driver's license.

CANCELLATIONS AND CHANGING YOUR DATE:

Cancellations (up to 7 days in advance of your Soaring® date): Full refund.

Cancellations (within 7 days of your Soaring® date): A fully transferable dollar credit may be used for to reserve a future Soaring® date. Should the rate increase prior to using the credit, the guest will pay the rate difference.

Changes to Reserved Soaring® dates: Dates may be changed, subject to availability, to other dates in the same season.
