On leaving the **TRIDENT AIRLINER CLUB ROOM** to **J** where you can view the de Havilland Pilot Training Centre and the **LINK** Trainer experience.

Exit the display, turn left and proceed to viewing area **K** where you can see the **DH DRAGON RAPIDE RESTORATION PROJECT** which will restore the aircraft to flying condition.

After viewing the various static aircraft proceed to display **1** featuring the **DH 121 TRIDENT FUSelage** and experience the interior of a 1960's airliner.

On leaving the hangar, proceed towards the outside static aircraft park **H**.

Exit the **WALTER GOLDSMITH HANGAR** and on your left you will see the **COMET 1A F** and the **SEA VIXEN** on your right. Beneath the wings are displayed two air-to-air missiles Red Top and Fire Streak. Behind this aircraft is the **SIR GEORFFREY de HAVILLAND HANGAR G** which displays the pre-war collection of aircraft, **CHIPMUNK, VAMPIRE** and various memorabilia.

On leaving the hangar, proceed towards the outside static aircraft park **H**.

After viewing the various static aircraft proceed to display **1** featuring the **DH 121 TRIDENT FUSelage** and experience the interior of a 1960's airliner.

On leaving the **TRIDENT AIRLINER CLUB ROOM** to **J** where you can view the de Havilland Pilot Training Centre and the **LINK** Trainer experience.

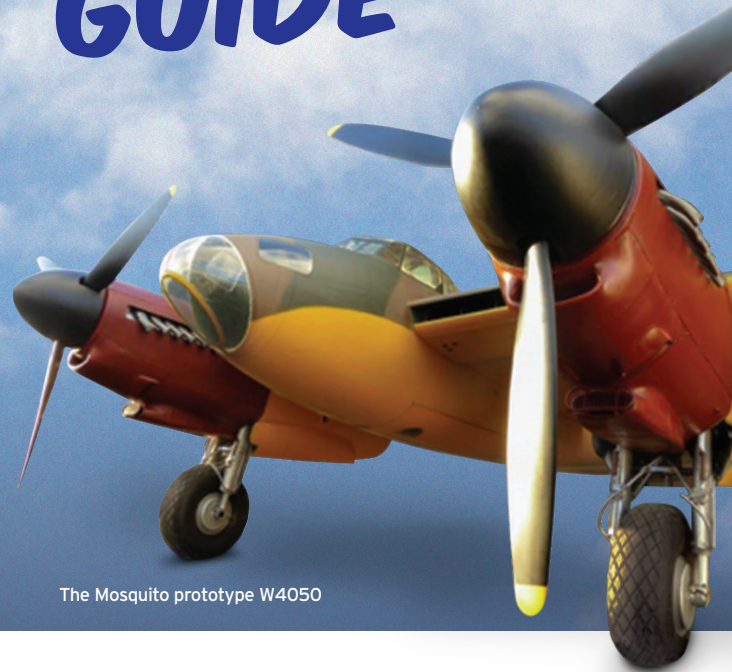

THE de HAVILLAND LEGACY CLOSE UP AND PERSONAL

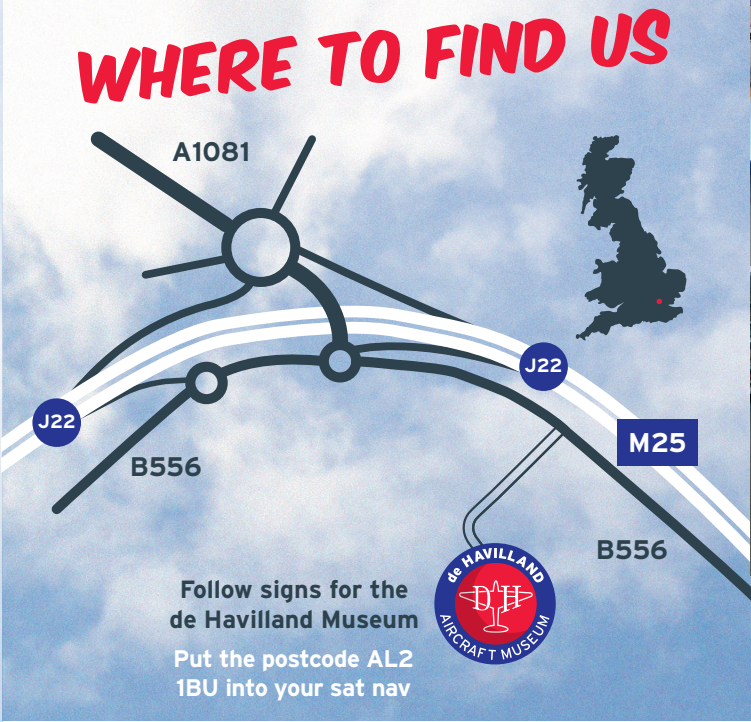


The historic site of Salisbury Hall, the home of the de Havilland Aircraft Museum, was chosen by the de Havilland Aircraft Company in 1939 as their secret design and development centre.

It is here that the iconic de Havilland DH98 Mosquito was designed and prototypes constructed. The first Prototype built, W4050 was designed as an unarmed bomber and the Museum has recently restored this rare aircraft, it is the only WWII prototype in existence. Over 41 variants of the "Wooden Wonder", as the Mosquito became known, were built and became the most versatile aircraft in WWII.

You can get close up to all our de Havilland aircraft exhibits giving a unique "hands on" experience of aviation history and technology. We are a "working Museum" so you'll see our volunteers restoring aircraft and they will be pleased to answer your questions.

Under the leadership of Sir Geoffrey de Havilland, the de Havilland Aircraft Company was responsible for many innovations in aviation technology, including iconic aircraft such as the Mosquito, Comet, Vampire, Tiger Moth and they designed the famous Horsa Glider, used on D Day and at Arnhem. De Havilland was also a major designer and manufacturer of Aero engines and Rocketry, you can see these and much more at the de Havilland Aircraft Museum.
