Terroir & French know-how

Located at the confluence of two rivers, the Dordogne and the Garonne, Château de Reignac enjoys two of the best soils of the Bordeaux area: the gravelly soil of the left bank normally found in the Medoc, and the clay-chalky soil of the right bank normally found in St Emilion. These two fantastic terroirs were formed over thousands of years by erosion. This unique phenomenon contributes to the creation of a top quality wine.
