MIRAVALLES CRATER & WATERFALLS



This trip is still almost a secret and takes us to one of Guanacaste's most active volcanoes: The Miravalles! An untamed mountain covered in rainforest and letting us safely visit the only walkable crater in Costa Rica. Our day on this trip is very diverse. Along our drive to the volcano we will visit one of the country's most beautiful waterfalls and if you liked to, you can bring your swimsuits and swim under the majestic water curtain. Our next stop will be the crater at Miravalles where we will see lots of geothermal activity and sense the mighty power from below us. We will have a volcanic mud bath and relax in the hot springs before lunch and then we will experience the tropical rainforest on a moderate hike along some breathtaking hanging-bridges and three more waterfalls! This is a day of waterfalls and volcano and is already one of our favorites!

Tenorio Nature Reserve & floating tour

We will walk through one of area's the most beautiful and protected patches of virgin rainforest, with chances of spotting the local wild life like toucans, currasows, guans, agoutis, lizards, frogs, snakes, white-nosed coatis and occasionally even the rare tapir.

After that Our driver/ Guide will take you to the second activity: The River cruise is a tour for the whole family (regardless of age) and your guide will do the rowing and also spot the plentiful wildlife along the ride. You can expect to see lots of water birds, like herons, egrets, ibis, roseate spoonbills, storks, kingfishers and also raptors, flycatcher, trogons and maybe even owls, toucans and parrots. Howler Monkeys, White-Faced Capuchins, Iguanas, Bats, Jesus Christ Lizards and Crocodiles are all commonly spotted.

After two hours on this pristine river you will have a traditional Costa Rican "Casado", which is a combination of rice, beans, salad, plantain, vegetable stew and a protein choice (fish, pork, chicken or beef)

Tenorio Hanging Bridges with Nature Reserve



Located on the slopes of the Tenorio Volcano, there will be a two-hour hike with many stops to see the variety of flora and fauna in the surrounding tropical rainforest.

You will walk on 4 hanging bridges over the forest canopy ranging from 35 to 40 meters in height. This is an excellent opportunity for observing, birds, butterflies, bromelias, orchids and become immersed in the splendor of the tropical jungle.

After that, the guide will take you through the multiple nature trails around the farm, closer to hanging bridge place, in search of sloths, monkeys, snakes, owls, birds and orchids. Passing through the nursery brimming with tropical plants and then wandering under the jungle canopies to visit the greenhouse where herbs and vegetables are produced.

You may be interested in the butterfly garden, and the life cycle of the butterfly, we will take you to our lab and then onto the butterfly garden in order to witness these beautiful transformations. The guide will also present the coffee process, including the various tools used and if its harvest time giving you a taste of the farm's own coffee. And last but not least you will meet Lola, the friendly goat.

Palo Verde National Park

Driving through the Country Site, you will arrive to enjoy a two-hour cruise along the river that has the nearest access to Palo Verde National Park. This river is one of most important of Costa Rica, because years ago, Tempisque River was used as a line of Transportation for people and goods like cattle and sugar cane. In addition, the river is considered one of the largest bird Sanctuaries in Central America. Tempisque River Possess large amount of birdlife, including aquatic birds such as herons, egrets, ibis, storks, roseate spoonbill and many other species. Other than birds, monkeys enjoy to climb and eat leaves and fruits from the trees along the river. The respected crocodiles and huge iguanas sit on rocks to warm up their bodies under the sun. The tour ends with a delicious typical Costa Rican meal.
