Pleasant Home is considered one of the nation's most distinguished examples of prairie school architecture.



Pleasant Home is an opulent 30-room historic house museum providing exciting opportunities to learn about the history and Prairie Style architecture of the early 20th century. It is a lasting tribute to architect George W. Maher and also to Pleasant Home's early owners: John Farson and Herbert Mills.

George W. Maher, Pleasant Home Architect

In 1939, the Park District of Oak Park purchased the home from the Mills family with the intended purpose of using the space as a community center and to promote social and cultural projects. Based on a Park District task force, the Pleasant Home Foundation was formed in 1990 to restore, maintain and operate the house as a museum for visitors to enjoy its rich architectural historic and cultural offerings.

In 1996, Pleasant Home was designated a National Historic Landmark, one of four in Oak Park. Today, it is the host to 20,000 visitors annually who experience the unique design and beauty of Pleasant Home.


