The Trust operates four elegant Edwardian style electric boats with a traditional canopy. Rosette, Stour Trusty II and Kathleen carry up to eight adult passengers, while Edwardian Lady can carry up to twelve adult passengers.



Francis J is a specially adapted, pontoon style boat that is suitable for passengers with impaired mobility; and can also accommodate a manually propelled wheelchair.

John Constable is a restored Stour lighter, as used in the time of the artist John Constable. She can carry up to twelve adult passengers in her open hold. This vessel is available for charter, and for trips between Sudbury and Great Henny. For further details and bookings please contact 01787 313199.

THE RIVER STOUR TRUST

The River Stour Trust is a registered charity, led by volunteers dedicated to the restoration and conservation of the River Stour Navigation for the benefit and enjoyment of the public. Originating in an act of Parliament in the reign of Queen Anne in 1705, the right to navigation has been preserved by the formation of the Trust in 1968. The Navigation was one of the country's earliest statutory rights of navigation and was made famous through the works of John Constable and Thomas Gainsborough, depicting working on the river and the beautiful Stour Valley.




