The day begins at the tribal village of Whakarewarewa where you will be guided through the geothermal landscape where Maori still live, have an exclusive visit to the ancestral house, view a Maori cultural performance and taste traditional foods.

In the afternoon we continue our ancestral footprints to Lake Tarawera where we travel by boat accross the

lake viewing our sacred mountain, learning of the amazing history and healing plants, visit Hot Water Beach, and bath in a natural geothermal hot pool before your return journey home.


After your walk reward yourself with a refreshing swim or a soak in the lake-edge hot water. We are the lakes sole dedicated pickup and dropoff
