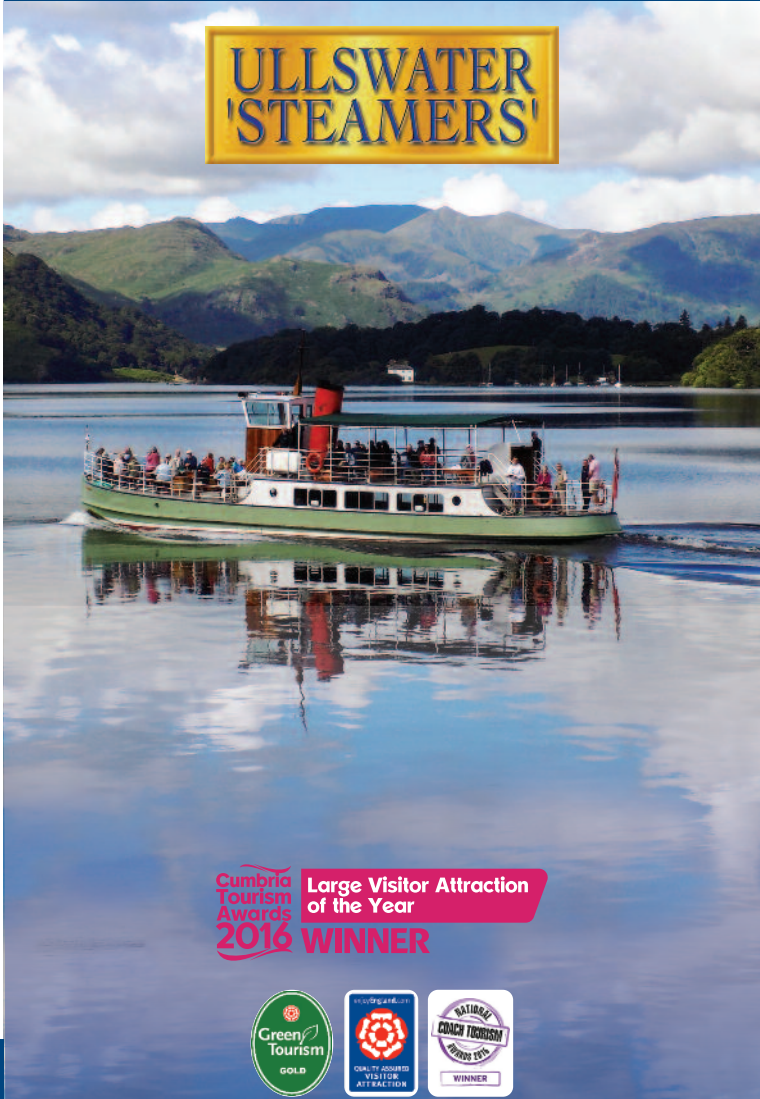

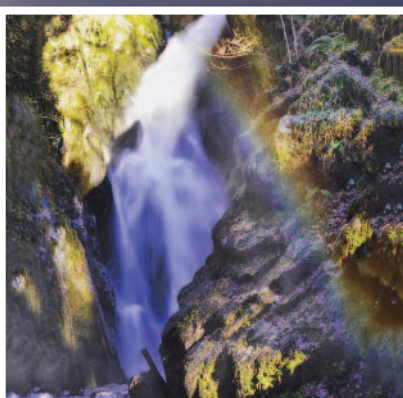
Famous Poets

The Ullswater Valley

Ullswater is 7.5 miles (12km) long and 0.5 miles (0.8km) wide, sitting at a height of 477ft above sea level. It is linked to Arthurian legends where monsters were believed to lurk beneath its dark waters. Maximum depth of 205ft (62m).



National Trust Aira Force

Discover the legend of Sir Eglamore, a Knight of high renown as you admire the exquisite falls from ornate stone bridges. Red Squirrel trails and outdoor natural play area too!

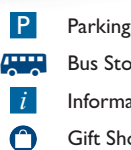

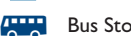
