DESCHUTES RIVER: CLASS III+

The Lower Deschutes River offers a beautiful desert canyon filled with sagebrush, osprey, incredible basalt rock formations and plenty of playful rapids. Beginners, families and experienced boaters alike love this river as much for its scenic beauty as for its location in the sunny, arid desert. It's not surprising that many people return to the Deschutes year after year.

Season: April - October Duration: Half-Day, Full-Day and Multi-Day

WHITE SALMON RIVER: CLASS III-IV

The White Salmon River offers world-class whitewater, breathtaking scenery, and dramatic basalt cliffs and waterfalls. Water level depending, half-day trips could conclude with an electrifying drop (optional) down 10-foot-high Husum Falls. Full-day trips include a float down a spectacular, narrow canyon below the former site of the Condit Dam.

Season: April - October Duration: Half-Day and Full-Day

CLACKAMAS RIVER: CLASS III-IV

Located 30 miles from Portland, the Clackamas River is known among whitewater boaters for its numerous, tumbling Class III-IV rapids and year-round accessibility. In the early season (March-June) snow melts create high flows and giant wave trains that are exciting for beginner and advanced rafters alike. As the water levels drop (July–Aug), the run becomes tighter and more technical.

Season: April - July Duration: Half-Day and Full-Day
