We offer a range of motorbikes to suite every rider's needs. Before each tour our tour leaders have all riders undergo a test ride to ensure they are on the right bike for them.

### **DIRT BIKES**

Experienced or larger riders who are after a bit more grunt can opt for one of our selection of 125cc, 150cc or 250cc Yamaha or Honda dirt bikes. With their taller suspension, manual gearbox and torquey engine, these dirt chewing machines are ideal for blasting along off road tracks or eating up the miles on any longer motorbike tour.

### **RETRO MINSK**

Go retro and ride one of our 125cc two-stroke Minsk – a machine as iconic as a motorbike can get. This manual bike, a Soviet copy of a WW2 era German MMZ is a highly versatile ride and can, more than any other machine be said to have helped build Vietnam. When you jump on to a Minsk you are becoming a part of a legend.

### **SEMI-AUTO SCOOTERS**

It is no accident the humble scooter is far and away the most popular form of transport in Vietnam. ## VILLAGE ADVENTURE TRACKS



We zoom out of Hoi An to explore the Thu Bon River Delta hinterland. We traverse irrigation channels, dyke walls and country laneways, all the while, soaking up the landscape and the local way of life. We stop for drinks at small, familyrun cafés, experiencing the everyday routine of the rural Vietnamese folk. On the return trip, we ride the unique "floating bridge" lane route, "high 5" with local kids and enjoy picturesque views of the sunset as it fades behind the mountains. This is a dream tour for amateur and professional photographers alike.

JEEP TOURS takes a different, though similar route though cannot visit the floating bridges or irrigations channels because the Jeep is too big. You will still see plenty of cool stuff.

Tour starts at 1pm and finishes approx. 5pm. (We can also run this tour in the morning.)

My family & I (Wife, kids 8, 7 & 6 yrs) took the half day motorbike tour around Hoi An and can only recommend it to anyone else that wants something different from the 'minibus and walk' that seems standard in the area. ## MY SON EXPLORER

The My Son tour begins with us departing by Jeep or motorbike with the sun chasing us into the beautiful Thu Bon Delta region. We stop at a bustling country market where you will get a real insight into Vietnamese country living. We then embark on a scenic drive along back roads the in the countryside and arrive at My Son for a traditional local Vietnamese breakfast. Once our stomachs are satisfied the guided My Son tour begins where we trek around the silent ruins of this ancient city.

After our My Son tour concludes we jump back on the bikes or Jeeps and return to Hoi An along small country laneways and through the scattered Hamlets amongst the rice paddies.

Tour starts at 5.30am and finishes approx. 10.30am.

We wanted to see My Son but at the same time, avoid the crowds. We found the perfect solution with HAMA's My Son Explorer adventure. We started off early and arrived early enough to enjoy the Cham ruins by ourselves. Led by our guide we were enthralled with the stories about the former kingdom, and were entertained with anecdotes. ## HIGHER THAN HAI VAN PASS



Hundreds of tourists a day pass over Hai Van Pass but few ever make it to Son Tra, an area of infinite beauty and blissfully-free of souvenir vendors. This day trip takes you from the lowlands to the mountains, stopping at several other viewpoints along the way that few tourists will ever get to see.

Your first stop is at Thap Bang An where we will visit a 900-year old Cham tower. Then zoom up Bo Bo Hill, also known as Hilltop 55, a site of historical importance during the American war before breaking for a coffee at a local shop. From here we begin the climb up to Son Tra reveling in the lush tropical vistas of the peninsula and the awesome riding. Rising 642 metres above the coast line, we snake around the mountain through dense foliage. Keep your eye out for monkeys, especially in the cooler months as there are plenty on the mountain. Then we descend along the other side of the mountain to see Vietnam's biggest Buddha statue and down toward the fishing villages where the colorful wooden boats are moored along the coast, making our way back to Hoi An.

Tour starts at 1pm and finishes approx. 5pm.

## HILL TRIBE VILLAGE ADVENTURE



### **DETAILED ITINERARY**

### **DAY 1: COUNTRYSIDE RIDING**

Get away from Hoi An for a night and discover a completely different side of Vietnam. Departing Hoi An by motorbike puts a whole new perspective on the Vietnam countryside, with fresh air and beautiful sceneries filling the senses. We'll first stop at 1000 year old Cham temples and former US and French bases from the independence wars.

We then wind our way into the mountains – this is what motorbike touring is all about! Travel along quiet roads, enjoying breathtaking sites at every turn with plenty of chances to stop for photos. There are some places you can only see on motorbike.

As we wind our way up into the hills towards the Lao border home to the Co Tu minority, we take a break to visit one of the few remaining Co Tu woodcarvers and enjoy a home cooked lunch in his stilted house before continuing our journey deep in to the mountains, meandering through isolated villages where the culture and traditions remain untouched by time making this remote and staggeringly beautiful region home to one of the most authentic hill tribes to remain in Vietnam.

We'll arrive at Bho Hoong, a traditional Co Tu village where we will stay for the night. Little has changed in the past hundred years in Bho Hoong and it is the perfect place to relax and enjoy the natural beauty of Central Vietnam. A light trek through the village outskirts takes us into the surrounding jungle and to rivers,

where we can go for a refreshing dip. The evening is highlighted by a superb dinner of Co Tu traditional dishes, a traditional cultural performance and a chance to interact with the villagers, gaining more insight into their rich culture. Afterwards, retreat to your stilted Co Tu hut where the serene setting and clear mountain air will lull you to sleep.

(Accommodation: Bungalow / Meals: Lunch, Dinner)

### **DAY 2: HO CHI MINH TRAIL**

In the morning, wake up to the sounds of the village coming to life. Enjoy breakfast and a hot cup of coffee as you watch the morning activities of the Co Tu, heading to the fields and preparing the days meals. We bid farewell to our hosts and jump back on the bikes for our return journey to Hoi An. Today's drive crosses the historic Ho Chi Minh Trail, through lush forests and past jaw-dropping views of the central Vietnam Mountains. Just when you thought it couldn't get any more beautiful we arrive at a waterfall tucked alongside a towering peak for a picnic lunch.

The afternoon sees us descending back down toward the coast, stopping along the way to explore old bases from the American war, crossing the Thu Bon River by local ferry (motorbike tour only. Jeep tour takes alternate route) and following our unique rural laneway and floating bridge road (motorbike tour only) back into Hoi An.



## HUE ADVENTURE LOOP



### **DETAILED ITINERARY**

### **DAY 1: COUNTRYSIDE RIDING**

We set off from Hoi An this morning on what promises to be an unforgettable voyage of rugged roads, rustic villages and stunning highlands.

With the wind in your hair, we zip through the Hoi An countryside, making our way up into the hills towards the Laos border. Home to the Co Tu minority, we take a break to visit one of the few remaining Co Tu woodcarvers and enjoy a home cooked lunch in his stilted house before continuing our journey deep in to the mountains, meandering through isolated villages where the culture and traditions remain untouched by time making this remote and staggeringly beautiful region home to one of the most authentic hill tribes to remain in Vietnam.

We'll arrive at Bho Hoong, a traditional Co Tu village where we will stay for the night. Little has changed in the past hundred years in Bho Hoong and it is the perfect place to relax and enjoy the natural beauty of Central Vietnam. A light trek through the village outskirts takes us into the surrounding jungle and to rivers, where we can go for a refreshing dip. The evening is highlighted by a superb dinner of Co Tu traditional dishes, a traditional cultural performance and a chance to interact with the villagers, gaining more insight into their rich culture. Afterwards, retreat to your stilted Co Tu hut (with a modern ensuite bathroom) where the serene setting and clear mountain air will lull you to sleep.

(Accommodation: Bungalow / Meals: Lunch, Dinner)

### **DAY 2: HO CHI MINH TRAIL**

Day two of your adventure begins with breakfast in the village and a chance to watch the morning activities of the Co Tu. Bidding farewell to our hosts; we jump on the bikes to resume our adventure through the rugged highlands of Central Vietnam. This time we follow a new section of the Ho Chi Minh Trail toward the Laos border, crossing through lush rainforests and over mountain passes on roads perfectly suited to motorbikes and Jeeps. Keep your camera handy as the views are stunning!

Midday we take a break for a picnic lunch in the shade of a mountain waterfall. Take a swim in the cool waters or simply lay back and relax in the solitude. We then begin the last stretch of today's journey, descending down to Hue. But the adventure isn't over yet. The landscape continues to change as we make our way to the flatlands, passing through A Shau valley- an area that played a key role during the American war- before catching glimpses of the iconic Perfume River from the hills. We cruise into the centre of Hue in the early evening.

### **DAY 3: HAI VAN PASS & COAST**

Rise and shine, it's time to set off on the final day of our adventure. Today's journey takes us back to Hoi An by a different route, trading in the mountains for the gorgeous Vietnam coastline. We head east from Hue and then travel parallel to the sea, passing through fishing villages and along pristine sandy beaches for the first part of the drive. The salty air and refreshing sea breezes are a dramatic contrast to the mountain air from the previous days. We'll stop often to dip our toes in the sea, chat with fishermen and to take photos. At the half way point of our drive we climb to Highway 1's highest point, Hai Van Pass, where panoramic views of the coast are all around. The road then winds down toward Hoi An, passing through Danang city, Marble Mountain and along the coastline.

Not all tour operators are licensed to operate tours. All our prices include 10% VAT and are advertised in VND.

#### **Prices:**

All our tour prices are fully inclusive of bike hire, petrol, food, entry tickets, non-alcoholic beverages, a tour leader. Multi-day tours include all accommodation, which varies from 3-4 star hotels, where available. We also provide international standard helmets, high-quality wet weather outfits, saddle bags and riding gloves, as well as luggage transfer for the transfer tours. A souvenir tour t-shirt is provided to participants on all 2 or 3 day tours and a long sleeve tour shirt for each participant in all our 4+ day tours. Tours with large groups will have a tour mechanic/and or support vehicle. And all tours finish with a complimentary cold beer or soft drink.

### Accommodation:

Prices are based on twin share. Single accommodation is available on request and on payment of a single supplement. We strive to use the best possible standard of accommodation wherever we go. From 4 star resorts to family run guest-houses, our accommodation will ensure your tour is comfortable even in the most remote destinations. Upgrades are always possible on request.

#### Food:

Vietnamese cuisine is famous throughout the world. Our tours showcase many great local restaurants where you can enjoy authentic local specialties. Throughout the day we supply a range of snacks and carry a gourmet picnic lunch or stop for a yummy local lunch, to give us the freedom to enjoy the spectacular scenery.

## BOOKING CONDITIONS

#### **INSURANCE**

All people on HAMA tours are required to have their own personal travel insurance. By booking the tour, you are warranting that you have insurance. You will provide details where asked and agree to hold Hoi An Motorbike Adventures harmless should any situation arise where you are required to make a claim on your insurance.

We recommend your travel insurance includes evacuation cover.

### PASSPORT / VISAS

All passengers must hold a valid passport and valid visa. It is your responsibility to obtain a current Vietnam visa. Hoi An Motorbike Adventures are a reputable business and can organize your letter of approval upon request.

#### **CANCELLATION**

#### Cancellation by Hoi An Motorbike Adventures

Hoi An Motorbike Adventures operates its tours in all weather. That is half the fun of riding a motorbike in tropical Vietnam. In the extremely unlikely event that Hoi An Motorbike Adventures is required to cancel a tour, and is unable to arrange a suitable replacement date with you, then a 100% refund applies.

### Cancellation by You

Cancellation fees apply to all cancelled reservations. Hoi An Motorbike Adventures incurs costs each time a tour is booked. The cancellation fee will be determined by the date Hoi An Motorbike Adventures is advised in writing that you cancel your booking.

### Cancellation Fees are as follows:

#### Half and Full-Day Tours

The booking is cancelled within 24 hours of tour departure date or once the tour has departed: the fee is 100% of the tour price. The booking is cancelled within a week of tour departure date though not within 24 hours of departure: the fee is 50% of the tour price.

### Overnight and Multi-Day Tours

The booking is cancelled within 7 days of tour departure date: the fee is 100% of the tour price.

### Refund:

Refunds are not made for any unused services. No refund will be made if you leave the trip early for any reason.

### **DEPOSIT & BALANCE**

All prices quoted are in VND and USD, and for all other currencies the payment is to be made using the exchange rate of the day: www.xe.com.

The payment can be made into our Vietnamese bank account or by using PayPal. You are responsible for any bank or PayPal charges. If you are already in Hoi An, you can come to our office and pay in cash or with your credit card.

A 25% deposit is required to secure your booking. The balance is to be paid no later than the day prior to your tour departure.

### **ITINERARIES**

Our tours are fantastic because they change regularly. We spent a lot of time researching (read: "having fun looking for new stuff to see") and ask all our guests for feedback so we can continue to improve our tours. The itineraries for our multi day tours will reflect the number of days on tour along with a broad itinerary; though we may include some things not included in the itinerary, because they are cool. It is difficult to put a comprehensive itinerary in place for a day tours because every day is different!

### SECURITY DEPOSIT

### This only applies to self-riders on our motorbike tours.

We take great care of our motorbikes. If you damage them on tour, we need to fix them. We take a security deposit of 1.000.000 VND to cover damage to the bike while it is in your possession on the tour. If the damage exceeds this amount you are responsible for it. We are in the business of ensuring your adventure is exciting and memorable. We are not in the business of overcharging or trying to take your money for damage. We are honest and fair and simply want to keep our bikes in the condition in which you received them.

Accidents and incidents on our tour are rare, though when they occur you are responsible for covering the cost to fix the bikes, up to and including full replacement value in the rare (really, rare) event of a write-off. Depending on the bike you choose you are looking at 1,500 USD for a Minsk (as they are becoming rare), 2,000 USD for a scooter, and 3,500 USD for a dirt bike. We do our best to take great care of you on tour, though we cannot ride the bike for you. So if in doubt, grab a driver and enjoy the ride from the best seat in the house!
