

San Andreas Fault Jeep Tour

Join a professional naturalist guide aboard one of our famous Big Red Jeeps and travel into the center of the San Andreas Fault zone at our private and exclusive Metate Ranch Preserve. Experience the twisted and tortured landscape of an active earthquake fault system on this exciting 4WD adventure. Walk between the steep walls of deep canyons created by the powerful forces of plate tectonics, water, wind and time. Explore a natural palm oasis where crystal clear water bubbles up from the underground aquifer. Learn about the culture and lifestyle of the Cahuilla Indians and how they used the desert's plants for food, medicine, tools, weapons, shelter and more. Enjoy spectacular views as your guide describes the geologic forces and local history that shaped the Coachella Valley. You can even experience the amazing shadows and colors on the hills on a Sunset Jeep Tour.




San Andreas Fault Nightwatch (Stargazing) Jeep Tour

Witness the transition from day to night on this exciting 4WD adventure that adds stargazing to our popular San Andreas Fault Jeep Tour. Travel to our private and exclusive Metate Ranch Preserve on the San Andreas Fault where you will learn about the desert's plants, animals, history, geology and earthquakes. On your journey you will visit a natural palm oasis, explore spectacular box and slot canyons, and view an ancient fossil bed as your jeep winds its way through the incredible labyrinth of geological cuts and canyons of the San Andreas Fault Zone. As the sun sets, witness the spectacular transition from day to night as the light casts amazing shadows and colors on the hills. Desert sunsets are magical, so be sure to bring your camera! When the sky darkens, you will be treated to a fascinating stargazing journey through the night sky.

Indian Canyons Jeep & Hiking Tour

Climb aboard one of our Big Red Jeeps for a visit to the ancestral home of the Agua Caliente Band of Cahuilla Indians. Your professional guide will educate and entertain you with stories about the history, culture, lifestyle and legends of the Cahuilla people. In Andreas Canyon, enjoy a guided 1-mile hike on a tranquil trail along the banks of Andreas Creek as your guide describes the ceremonies and legends of the Cahuilla people and explains how they used the desert's plants for survival. View one of the largest natural palm oases in North America from the rim of Palm Canyon. Then enjoy a short walk to a hidden water cave where the water flows most of the year. At the end of your adventure, shop for unique gifts and souvenirs at The Indian Trading Post. *PLEASE NOTE: This is NOT an off-road / 4WD tour.*



Painted Canyon / Mecca Hills Jeep Tour

Experience colorful canyon walls, spectacular vistas, and local agriculture on this east-valley 4WD / back country adventure. The adventure begins with a fully narrated trip through fields of produce growing in our valley's rich agricultural district. Depending on the time of year and growing conditions, table grapes, dates, artichokes, peppers, strawberries, and even exotic mangos may be seen flourishing in the fields. After rising above the agricultural basin, you will behold an awe-inspiring view of the Salton Sea from a vista point. The majestic Mecca Hills Wilderness Area offers some of the most amazing scenery in the valley - including the vibrantly colored mineral striations of Painted Canyon. Enjoy one of the included hikes that range in difficulty from an easy nature walk to the "Hike of Death."

Palm Springs City & Celebrity Home Tour

Since the 1920's, Palm Springs has been the playground for Hollywood's elite including Frank Sinatra and his Rat Pack, Liz Taylor, Marilyn Monroe, Elvis Presley, and Liberace, to name just a few. To this day, just the mention of Palm Springs evokes images of Tinseltown's biggest stars laying in the warm desert sunshine sipping cocktails by the pools of their private estates. Join us as we reveal the sizzle and scandal that defined the Hollywood scene in the desert. Your guide will describe how and why Palm Springs became the town of choice when Hollywood needed to let its hair down. With a liberal dose of star gossip, mid-century architecture, pop culture and history, this jeep (weather permitting) tour is sure to keep you fascinated and entertained! We also offer a version of this tour that focuses on the LGBT influence in Palm Springs.



Joshua Tree National Park Van/SUV Tour

Journey through two deserts and the transition zone between two eco-systems on a fascinating excursion to one of the newest parks in the National Park system. On the way to the park, you will enjoy a narrated tour of the Coachella Valley and learn about the wind and solar energy generated from the San Geronio Pass wind and solar farms. Your guide will also provide an in-depth overview of the area and formation of Joshua Tree National Park. Inside the park, you will learn about the plants and animals of the high desert and hear stories of the rich history of the area. Enjoy a guided hike to Hidden Valley, featuring a jaw-dropping photographic wonderland of majestic rock formations. Then take in the spectacular view at the Key's View Overlook which offers a stunning viewpoint from 5,185 ft. in elevation. This tour includes a picnic lunch in the park.
