A Bit About Us

Downstairs, on your left as you walked in is the Public Bar. The bar top is made from recycled timber from Mornington Pier. Wherever possible we've tried to retain the original features of the hotel. The exposed beams originally came from a power station in the UK, the façade is heritage listed and where we had to recreate features, we did so with this in mind. Our chairs and stools were hand made and we've put a lot of thought into everything we offer.

The front part of the hotel was built in 1894, with the rear portion being added in the 1940's. The building is a mixture of Victorian and Deco architecture. The Brunswick area was established in 1839 as a bluestone quarry. Once these were exhausted the area became a hub for textile manufacturing. The area is currently undergoing a period of renaissance, becoming a hub for dining and entertainment.

Acquired in February 2014 The East Brunswick Club or The East as it was affectionately known had been closed and neglected for over 2 years. The old girl has undergone a full renovation - quite literally from the cellar up. A band venue for over a decade, The East has played host to some of Australia's best-known rock and international acts.

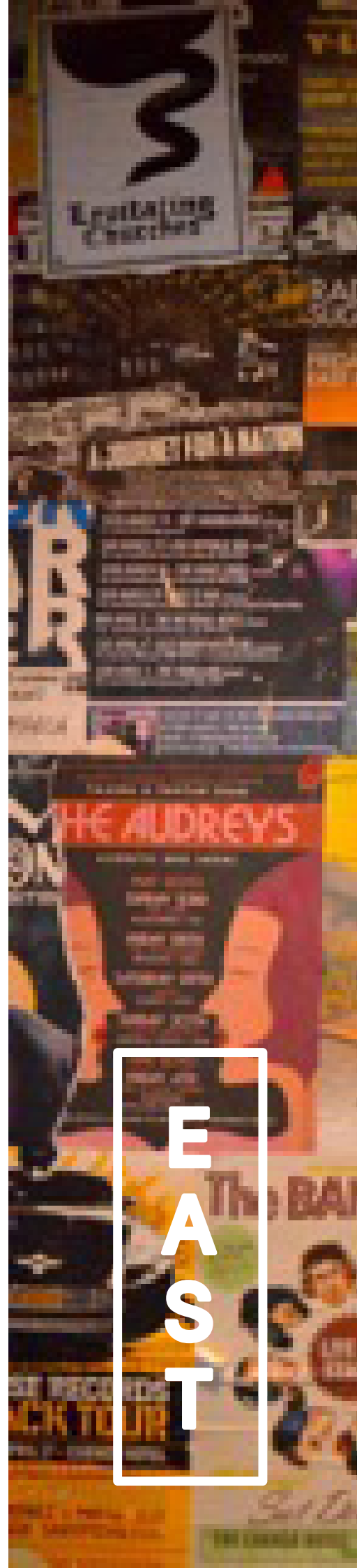

The Fine Print

The East Brunswick Hotel

A valid form of I.D. is required to stay here - driver's licence, passport, plus a credit card in the same name as the I.D.

Apartments must be left in a relatively clean & tidy condition on departure and all rubbish placed in the bin. If the apartment is deemed "un-rentable" for any fair reason a standard nights accommodation may be charged to the credit card provided.

The East Brunswick is a non-smoking establishment and as a result, where management determines the presence of any smoking residue in any apartment, a \$200.00 additional cleaning charge will be applied to the credit card supplied to cover costs of dry-cleaning of curtains, furnishing etc. Any furnishings or other items damaged by cigarettes will be charged at the full purchase price.

We love animals, but not in here - pets are not allowed in our apartments or property unless previously arranged and confirmed in writing from hotel management. A \$500.00 additional cleaning charge will be applied to the credit card supplied for pets found in or around the property. Guide dogs and assistance dogs accredited by Assistance Dogs Australia are welcome any time.

The East Brunswick reserves the right to evict any person/s from the premises immediately and without notice, or refund for any disturbances or unruly behaviour causing disruption to other guests.

Your room key & fob will get you into all parts of the hotel you're supposed to be in and allows after-hours access through the side door on Albert St. Keep hold of it tight - lost keys will set you back \$250.00. The hotel is alarmed after hours so don't wander in where you shouldn't. Please.

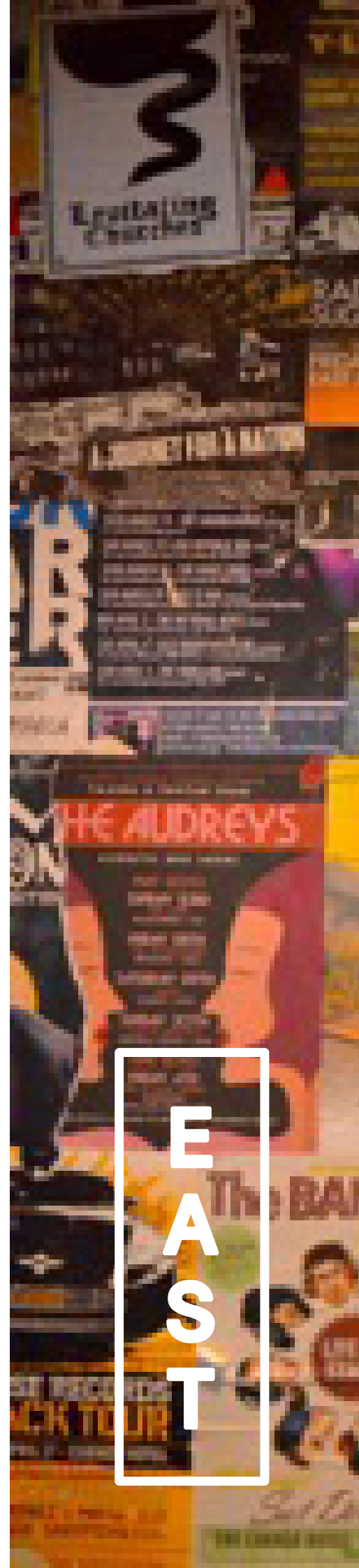

Internet access is complimentary and WI-FI is available in all bedrooms and public rooms of the property. Your room is also equipped with NBN.

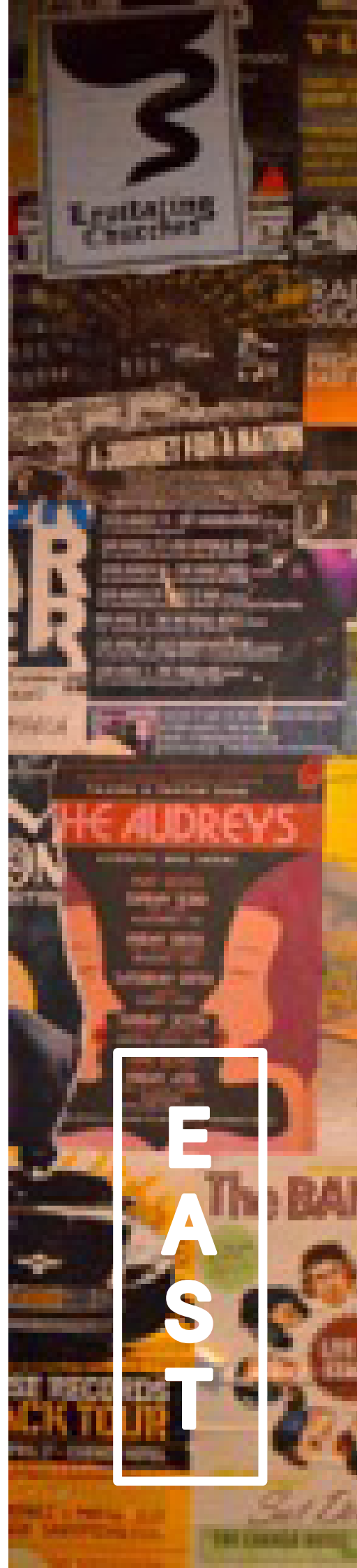

The first floor bar with its balcony provides an alternative space for drinkers and diners and may be hired for intimate functions and for cocktail style events for up to 80 people.

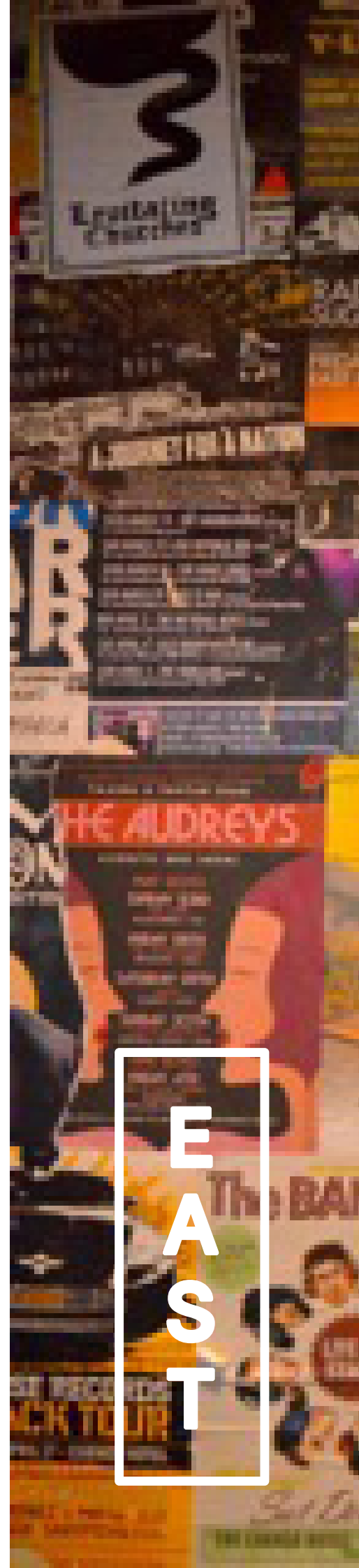

Our Rooms

ROOM 10 - HEMINGWAY

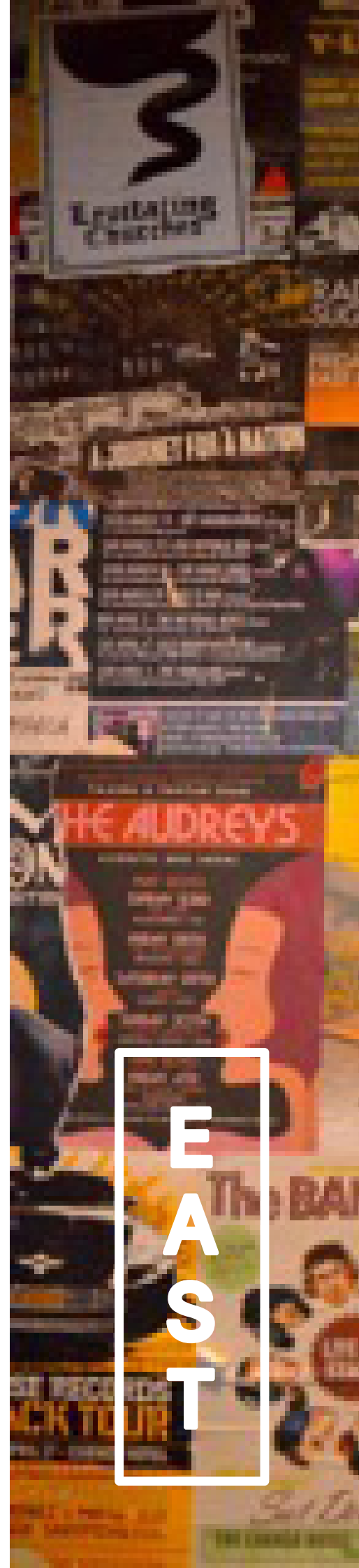
The story room and perhaps one of the greatest story tellers of our time. Take some time to read the pages on the wall.
