Opened in 1832, Glasnevin is Ireland's National cemetery covering 124 acres (over 50 hectares); where over 1.6 million people are laid to rest including the iconic **Brendan Behan & Luke Kelly.**

THE O'CONNELL TOWER

Visitors can now climb the iconic O'Connell Tower, Ireland's tallest round tower. Climb the 198 steps to stunning views of the cemetery, Dublin, Wicklow & the Irish Sea. Built to honour Daniel O'Connell, the ornate crypt where he has been laid to rest forms the base of the tower.
