Once you arrive in Page, Arizona, your Navajo guide will take you on a two hour tour into the heart of Antelope Canyon sharing the important history, culture and geology of this spectacular region. From there, you'll embark on a scenic walk to Horseshoe Bend which features incredible views of the deeply carved channel and the Colorado River far below. Additional viewings and photo opportunities include majestic Lake Powell and Lees Ferry, Navajo Bridge and an active Navajo Trading Post.

You will visit Goldfield Ghost Town, the old stagecoach stop at Tortilla Flat, and stunning Canyon Lake, where you will board the Dolly Steamboat for a cruise. Aboard the cruise, guests will enjoy views of awe-inspiring rock formations and the dramatic cliffs of the rugged Superstition desert wilderness.

It is here that some of the West's most colorful characters are laid to rest. A truly unique stop on this tour is the "White Dove of the Desert", the mission of San Xavier del Bac. This working mission was built in 1692 and remains one of the region's best preserved Spanish settlements.


