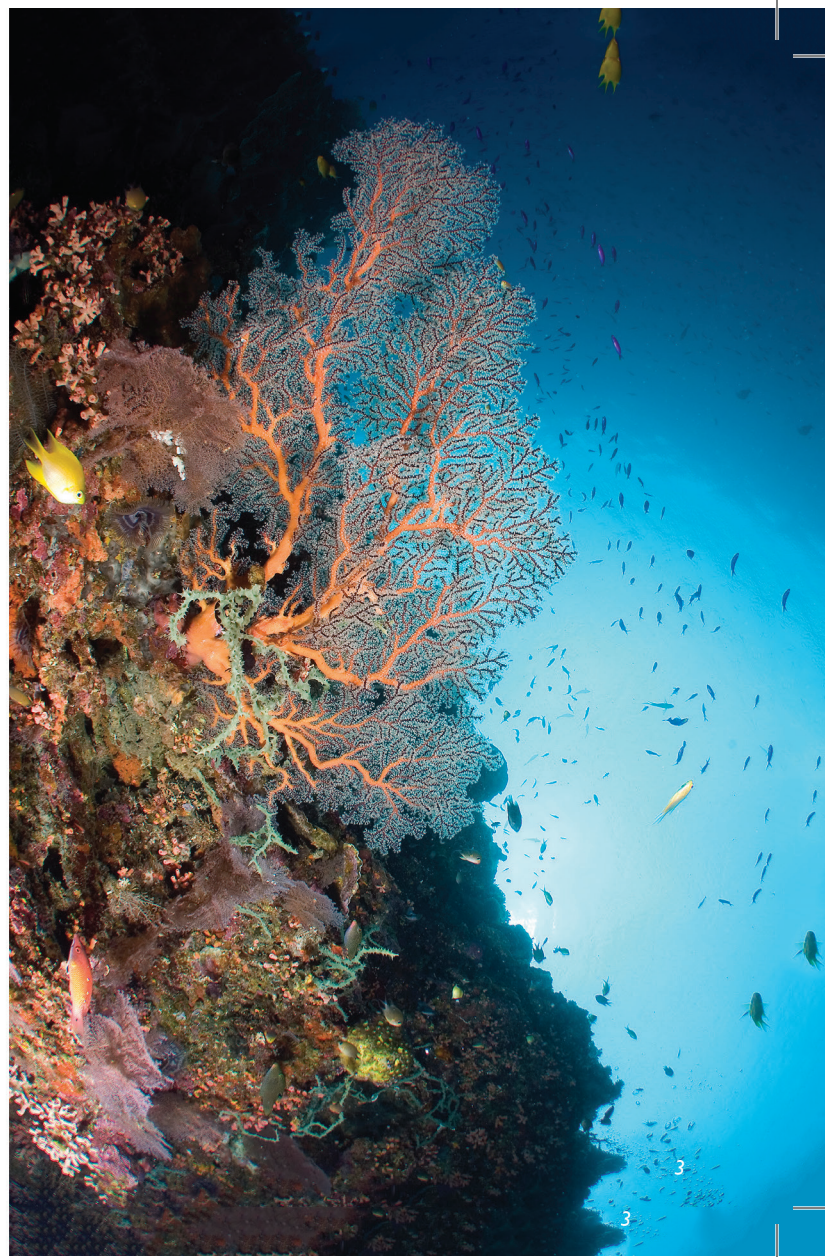

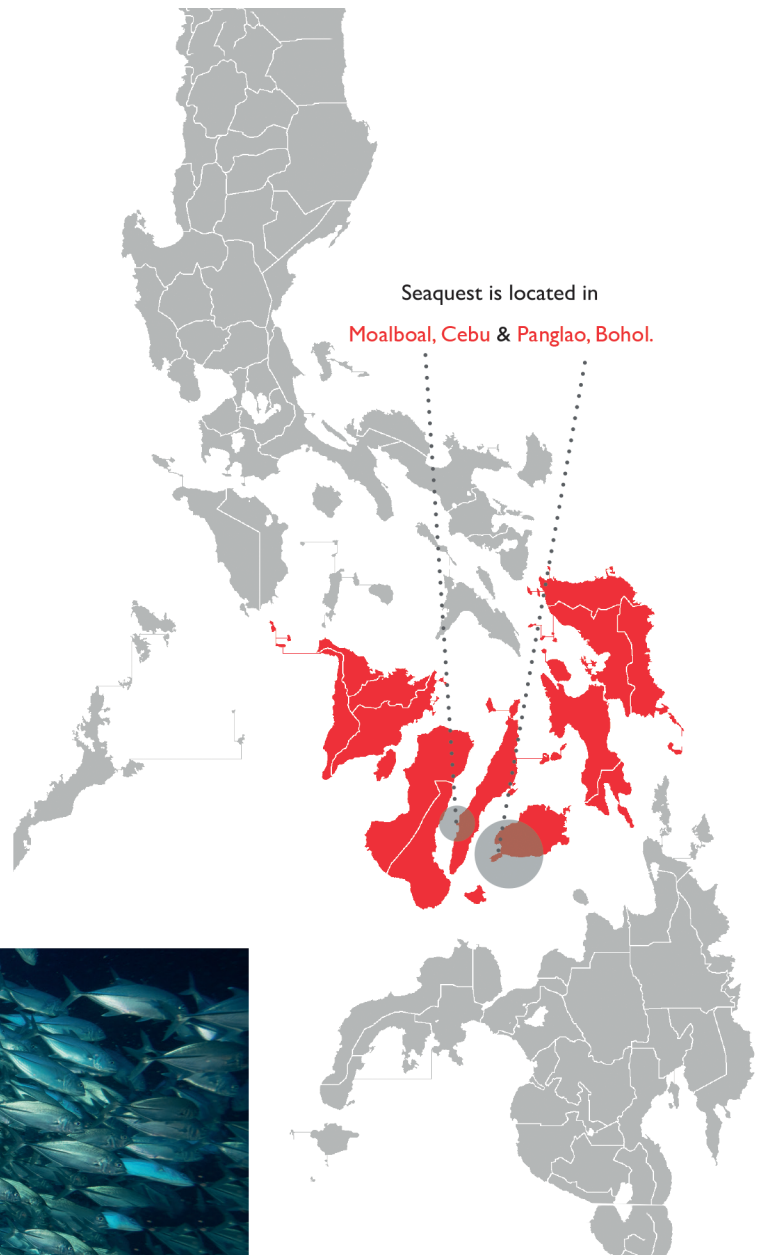
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The second largest archipelago in the world, with over 7000 islands, the Philippines is one of the great treasures of Southeast Asia. Below sea level, the string of coral-fringed islands boast some of the world's best diving and snorkeling across the vast expanse of the western Pacific.

The beaches are white and palm fringed, the sea is a mosaic of turquoise waters home to hundreds of coral species and even more species of fish. The locals are very friendly and are ever so keen to meet and greet you. They are well-known for their friendliness and hospitality. Throughout the archipelago they speak about 80 different dialects but almost everyone speaks English!

The value for money in the Philippines is incredibly good for Western standards. Visa and Mastercard are accepted at all our establishments. The unit of currency in the Philippines is the Peso (PHP).

The seas in the Philippines are considered amongst those richest in marine biodiversity. The water is flat, blue and warm (25°C to 30°C) and weather conditions allow diving all year round.

If you are bringing your own equipment then you will probably want a 3-5mm wetsuit. Mostly all of the rental gear is of the renowned Italian brand - Cressie-Sub. 10, 12 and 15 liter tanks with international and DIN valves are available. The dive cylinders are filled (200 Bar) by Bauer. Nitrox cylinder fills up to 32% available. Each diver has their own crate in the dive shop to store their dive gear overnight.

Most dives are with 4 divers to a dive guide. However the number might change. Nearby dive sites are accessed by speedboats that are equipped with sunroofs and for our day trips we use our comfortable local style "outrigger" banca.



Being one of the first dive centers at Alona Beach, we pioneered the exploration of now well-known dive sites and even have some named after our veteran dive masters.

Our efforts have put the Philippines on the map for diving enthusiasts everywhere and our experience ensures that our guests are in the most capable hands.
