About Us

It all started in 1953 when Sir William Hamilton invented the world renowned Hamilton Jet. Soon after, in the summer of 1960, Kawarau Jet was born in Queenstown, becoming the world's first commercial Jet boat operation.

For over 40 years we have shown holidaymakers from all around the world how exhilarating Jet boating can be. Kawarau Jet Queenstown is locally owned and operated by Shaun & Sally Kelly, partnered by Southern Discoveries.

With such a successful history it was decided that the same experience could and should be enjoyed by visitors to the North Island's cultural adventure capital Rotorua. The Rotorua operation is owned and operated by Shaun's brother and sister in law Ross & Fiona Kelly.

Kjet Rotorua operates three purpose built jet boats; Kjet3 surveyed for 11 people running a 383 Chev, Kjet4 surveyed for 18 people which is running a experimental turbo powered engine and Kjet5 surveyed for 25 people running twin 350 Chevs. For the last five years Kjet Rotorua has also been using high octane biofuel containing 10% bioethanol. All our boats use the tried and trusted Hamilton 212 jet units.

In 2010 our newest venture Kjet Parasailing was launched. A purpose built 25 foot Parasailing boat, decked out in Kjet yellow accommodates seating for up to 10 passengers, 2 operators and is powered by two 150 HP Yamaha Four Stroke engines.

A NZ standards Qualmark endorsed activity, Kjet Rotorua combines the cultural aspects of the area with the speed and world famous Hamilton Spins. But this is just the beginning. With an endless range of combo's and activities, Kawarau Jet Rotorua and Kjet Parasailing will be a hard act to follow.




30min Jet Tour - Lake Rotorua

Mokoia Island - Guided Tour

Located in the middle of Lake Rotorua, Mokoia Island is one of the area's best keep secrets. This beautiful and tranquil Island features heavily in in many local stories and historical events. The Island is a wildlife sanctuary and is home to approximately 25 Kiwi, 5 endangered Species, 20 protected species and over 40 common species, which now call it home. The birds flourish in this predator free environment, filling the canopy with their songs.

The island's foreshores are littered with natural, geothermal springs, including the famous Hinemoa's Hot Pool. There are a number of walking tracks around the Island which wind their way up to the summit and a 360 degree unobstructed, breath-taking view of the surrounding area.

Plunge into the crystal clear lake, down the water slide, or lay on the golden beaches and soak up the sun. KJet Parasailing

Our latest adventure experience is literally "taking off". Kjet Parasailing is a truly unique experience where you can sit back, relax and enjoy the exhilaration of free flight up to 400 feet and some of the best views in the world.

Launching from the flight deck of our 26 foot purpose built parasail vessel, equipped with twin 140 Yamaha 4 stroke engines, the trip on the boat lasts about 30 minutes to one hour, with about 10-12 minutes of actual airtime seated in the parasail behind the boat. You will take off and land directly from the boat, so no water contact is necessary. No prior experience is required.

- Solo and tandem flights available
- No experience required, altitude and direction controlled by your parasail pilot
- Allow 30 minutes for full duration
- Some of the best views of Rotorua and the surrounds
- Minimum age 10 years and restrictions apply

Kawarau Jet have combined two of the areas most popular adventure activities to create the ultimate combo - "SkyJet". Experience the excitement and exhilaration of Jet Boating with the thrill of being flown up to 400 ft in the air with K-Jet Parasailing.

Feel the rush and the power as our V8's push you through the water at approximately 85km/hr, while our professional drivers thrill you with speed, spins and adrenalin. Once back at the dock you will be transferred to our Parasailing Team who will fly you up to 400ft in the air to see what the birds see. Launching from the flight deck of our 26 ft purpose built parasail vessel, you will experience unobstructed views of this stunning area. You will take off and land directly from the boat, so no water contact is necessary and No previous experience is required.

FAQ's

How fast does the jet boat go?

The K-Jet jet boat can reach speeds up to 85km an hour, so pretty fast!

Does it get very rough out on the lake?

Lake Rotorua is usually quite calm, but this is New Zealand's most unpredictable lake and we have reported up to 3 metre swells before!

How long before departure should I be there?

10 minutes

How old do you need to be to go on a trip?

Kawarau Jet has no age restrictions and our jet boat rides are quite safe and a lot of fun for young children and adults alike.

Can seniors take part?

Absolutely!

Will I get wet?

Very likely! But it does depend on where you sit in the boat and we do have spray jackets available if you don't want to get wet.

How many people can go on the boat?

Kjet 3 can take 11 people, Kjet 4 can take 18 people and Kjet 5 has room for 25 people.

Can I fall out of the boat?

No, falling out of the boat is very unlikely. The driver will explain what to do and what not to do to prevent falling out.

What should I bring?

Sunglasses are recommended as well as sun block, in the cooler months wrap up warm. Spray and life jackets are provided.

Is transport offered?

Airport transfers are available.



Rotorua Fleet



Kjet 1

A 26-foot, purpose-built parasail vessel, equipped with twin 150 Yamaha 4 stroke engines. Surveyed for 12 passengers and 2 crew, KJet 1 is the unlimited tailor made parasailing boat that offers dry take offs and landings.

Kjet 3

Kjet3 surveyed for 11 people running a 383 Chev.

Kjet 4

KJet.4 is surveyed for 18 people and is currently running an experimental XR6 Turbo motor. Once the Research and Development is complete this boat will be fitted with twin XR6 Turbo engines making it one of the fastest commercial jetboats in the country.



Kjet5 surveyed for 25 people running twin 350 Chevs. For the last five years Kjet Rotorua has also been using high octane biofuel containing 10% bioethanol. All our boats use the tried and trusted Hamilton 212 jet units.
