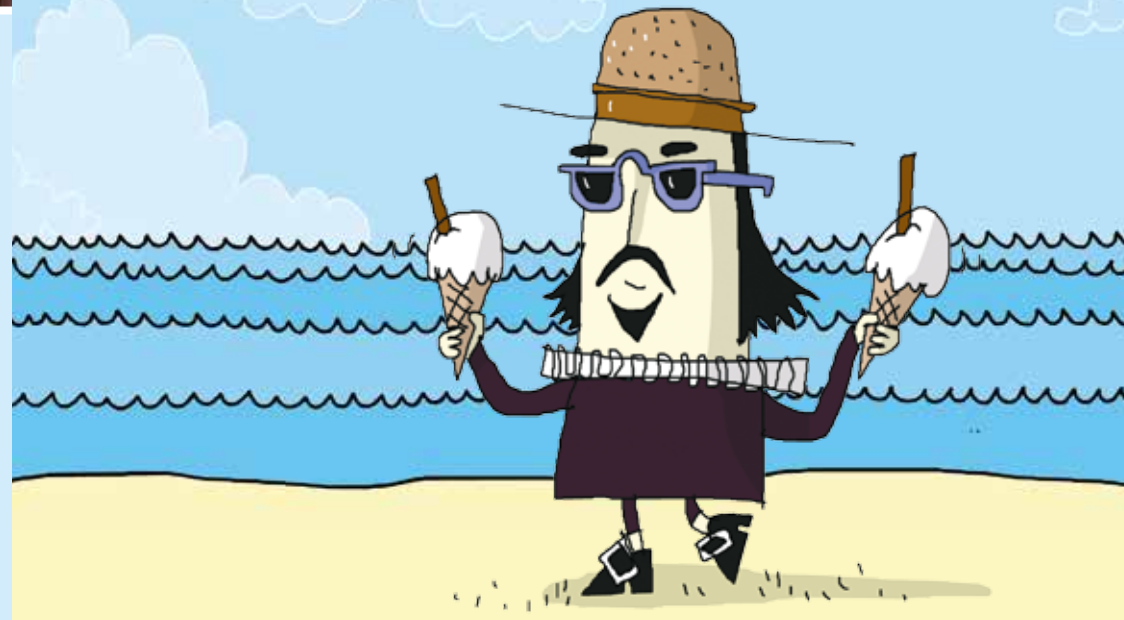
During Warwickshire school holidays we run an additional programme of workshops and activities for children, young people and their families. Many of these are free.

GUIDED THEATRE TOURS

DISCOVER WHAT GOES INTO MAKING AN RSC PRODUCTION AND EXPLORE OUR THEATRES IN MORE DEPTH. THERE ARE A RANGE OF AVAILABLE TOUR ROUTES AND ALL ARE SUITABLE FOR FAMILIES.

A **Behind the Scenes Tour** focusses on the current productions and how they have been created. (£8.50 adult, £4.50 child)

The **Other Place Tour** takes you through the rehearsal process, while explaining the journey of developing a play from being words on a page of a script, to a performance in front of an audience. (£8.50 adult, £4.50 child).

The **Front of House Tour** explores the public areas of our building, sharing highlights of our history as well as behind the scenes secrets like how costumes are made and how effects are achieved. (£6.50 adult, £4 child).

TOWER

See Shakespeare's home town from a different perspective when you visit the Tower. A lift will take you to the viewing platform for panoramic views of Stratford-upon-Avon and beyond. (£2.50 adult, £1.25 child).
