

the infamous fifteenth / sixteenth century Pirate Queen, Grace O'Malley (Grannuaile).



The vessels which are the largest and most modern ferries operating to Clare Island and Inishturk, are registered with the Department of the Marine & Failte Ireland and both have a Certificate for 96 passengers.



Extra sailings for groups of 6 to 35 passengers can be arranged aboard the MV Very Likely up to 12 passengers, or aboard the MV Sea Sprinter up to 35 passengers. These boats can be chartered for sightseeing, diving, fishing or trips to and from other Islands like Clare Island, Achill or Inishturk.




Clare Island



The cruise across to the Islands gives you plenty of time to view and photograph a most spectacular coast line, which includes Achill Island, Westport, Croagh Patrick, Louisburgh, the Connemara Mountains and Inishbofin Island.

Grace O'Malley's Castle



On the rocky headland at Clare Island harbour is the square tower which served as Granuaile's Castle. Clare Island was the stronghold of this 16th century O'Malley Clan Chieftan who lived by her family trade of Piracy and Plunder. So widely feared was 'Granuaile' (as she was known), that she was received with full honours at the Tudor Court of Elizabeth 1st. She maintained her dominance into old age, died in her seventies in 1603, and was buried in the Cistercian Abbey on Clare Island. Clare Island has a winter population of approx 150. It still maintains many old traditions and has a very rich archaeological history.
