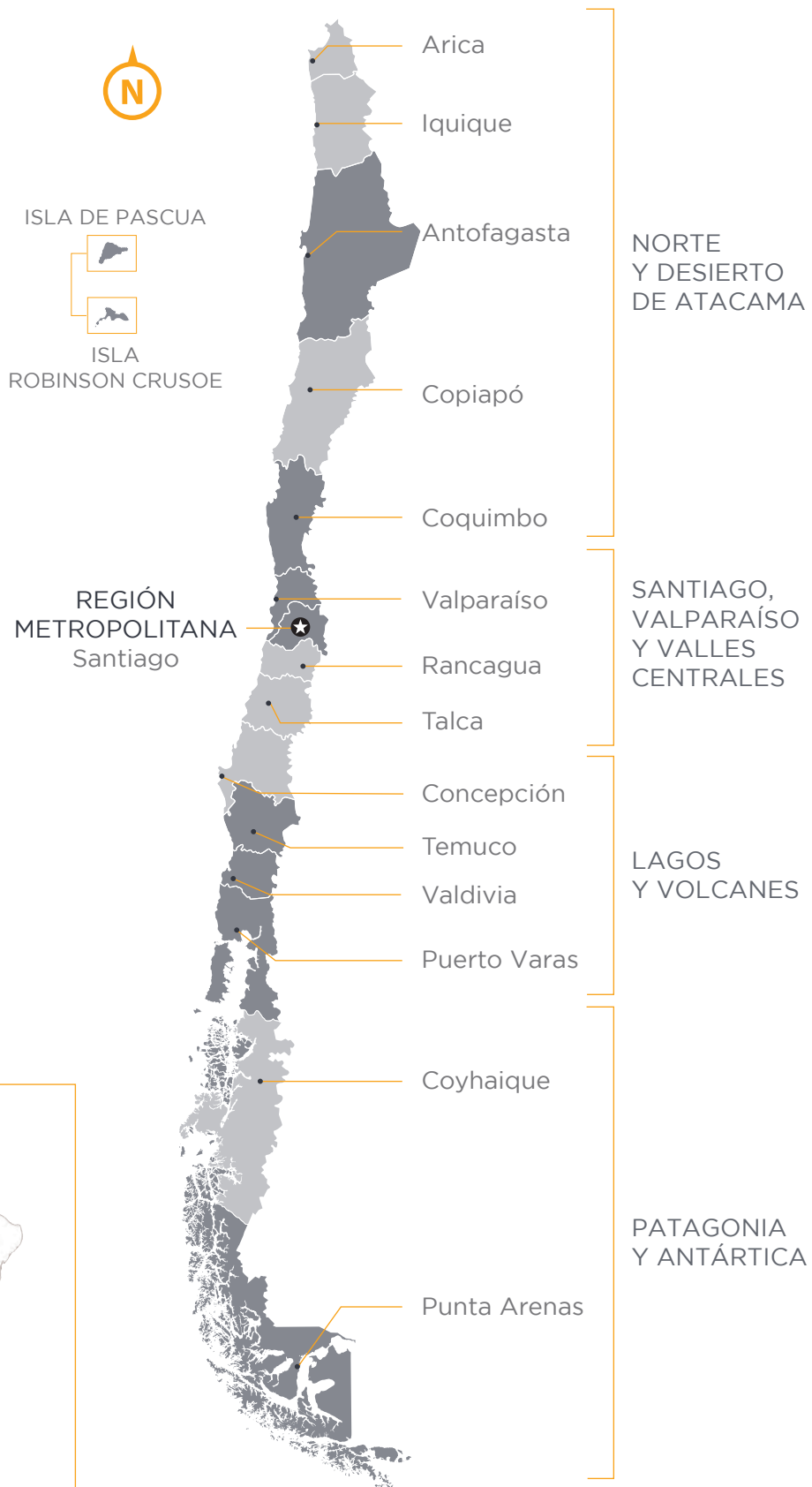

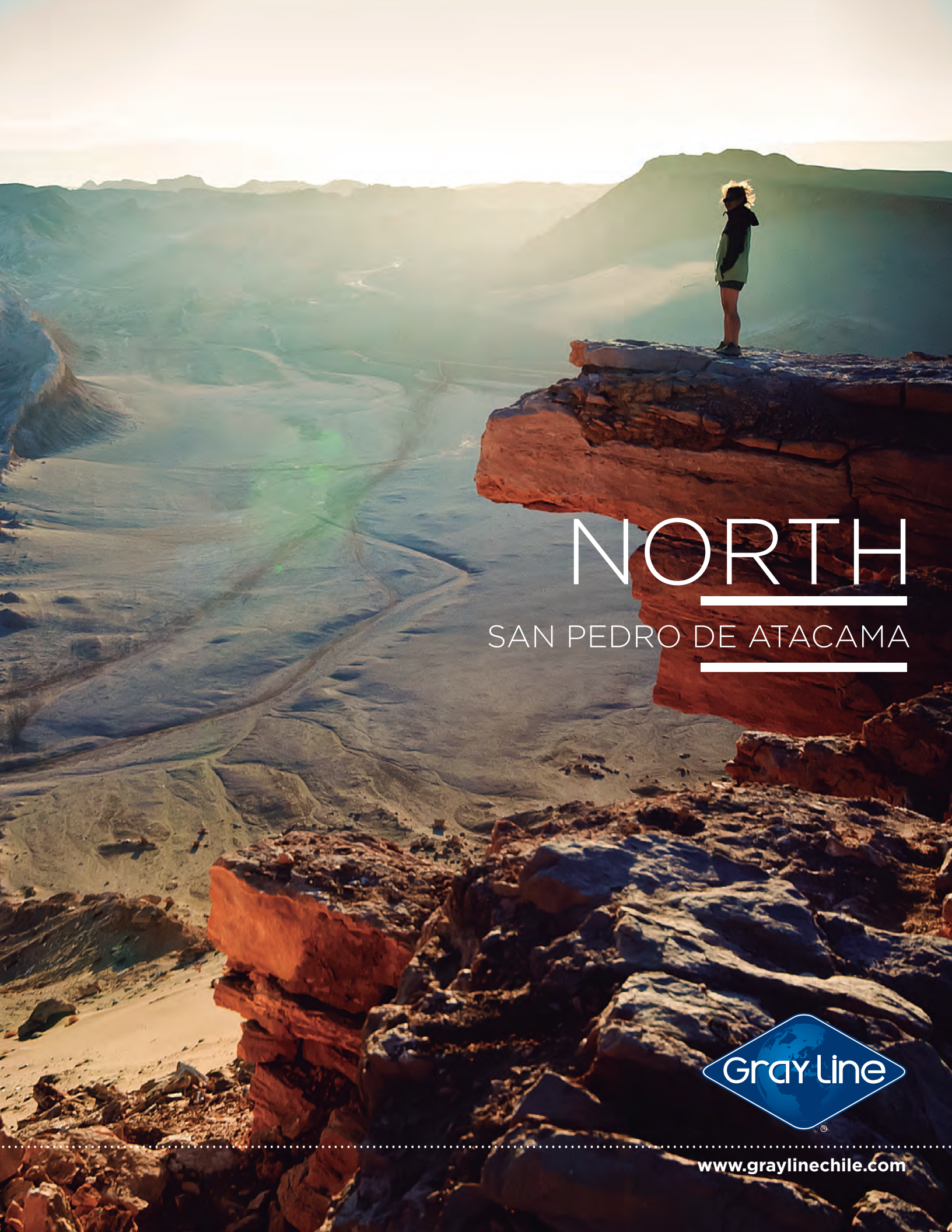

## THE ROUTE OF CHURCHS IN CHILOÉ

The geography of the Chiloé Island is compose by farms, ocean and forests. With a unique culture, reflected in their constructions, gastronomy, mythology and the hospitality of their people who are a mix of Spanish settlers and Huilliche people.

The palafitos are houses constructed with piles over the sea, and they are one of the great attractions of Chiloé.

The Island of Chiloé has a hundred of churches, all of them constructed since the 18th century in wood and without nails.

- 16 CHURCHES IN CHILOÉ were declared World Heritages by UNESCO.
- WILD NATURE IN CHILOÉ, where you can see penguins, seabirds, sea otters and dolphins watching. On the Northeastern Coast of Chiloé is the largest concentration of Blue Whales of the Southern Hemisphere.

## IN THE MIDDLE OF IMPRESSIONING GLACIERS

The Glaciers are amazing natural constructions: Its irregular structures and colors that change from transparent, white and bluish, in addition of the breathtaking sound when ice pieces are detached.

The Patagonia is the third largest expanse of ice in the world.

In Chile, Patagonia is divided in Campos de Hielo Norte and Campos de Hielo Sur (north and south ice fields). With an ice extension of 21.000 kms<sup>2</sup>, it amazes for its awesome and millenary presence.

Campos de Hielo Sur Glaciers, Pio XI is located inside Bernardo O'Higgins National Park, the largest in the Southern Hemisphere (265 kms<sup>2</sup>), excluding the Antarctica.

O'Higgins Glacier, located in O'Higgins Lake, where The "Carretera Austral" ends, and the Glaciers Tyndall and Grey can be seen in Torres del Paine National Park.

# NORTH OF PATAGONIA

---

## CAPILLAS DE MÁRMOL

Declared a Nature Sanctuary, located in General Carrera Lake, it is a group of islands and small islets of marble. They are strange formations that express the aesthetic perfection of nature.



## QUEULAT PARK “WATERFALLS SOUNDS”

The Ventisquero Colgante Glacier and the coastal temperate rainforest becomes in the perfect retreat for the fauna and flora.

Located in Aysén area, south of Chaitén, and 165 kms to the north of Coyhaique

## TORRES DEL PAINE NATIONAL PARK

Torres del Paine National Park is one of the most amazing destination of the Chilean geography.

Declared a World Biosphere Reserve, by UNESCO in 1978, in addition selected as the 8th WONDER OF THE WORLD.

It is a protected area of 227.000 hectares. It has lakes, glaciers, rivers, waterfalls, forests and its particular granite towers, which have positioned Chile as one of the most important natural destinations on earth.

## PENGUINS & WHALES

Marvelous landscapes, with a large variety of fauna that surprise for its adaptation to live in an inhospitable environment, ideal for watching and photography.

From November to March, weather conditions are optimal.
