# FRANK LLOYD WRIGHT'S *Kentuck Knob*



In 1953, I.N. and Bernardine Hagan purchased 89 acres in the mountains above Uniontown in Western Pennsylvania. After falling in love with Fallingwater, they commissioned Frank Lloyd Wright to design a house for them. This was one of the last homes to be completed by Wright.

Designed on a hexagonal module, Kentuck Knob is a small one-story Usonian house—a signature design of Wright. Both dramatic and serene, the house is situated just below the crest of a hill and appears almost part of the mountain itself. An open floor plan, cantilevered overhangs and great expanses of glass effortlessly integrate the inside with the outside.



Additional attractions for the visitor include sculptures by contemporary artists such as Claes Oldenburg, Sir Anthony Caro, Andy Goldsworthy, and many others, that have been integrated into the landscape.



## REGULAR HOUSE TOUR

*Approx. 45 minutes. Available daily.*

This tour takes guests through the interior and exterior of the home and provides insight into one of Frank Lloyd Wright's most unique Usonian homes. Learn about the Hagans, Frank Lloyd Wright, and his vision for the home. After the tour, guests may explore the grounds, sculpture collection, and experience the magnificent view of the Youghiogheny River Gorge.

## IN-DEPTH HOUSE TOUR

*Approx. 90 minutes. Limited to groups of 10 or less.*

This tour offers an extended interpretation of the house, including secondary spaces not available on the Regular House Tour, providing a deeper understanding of the building as well as highlighting some of the collections. After the tour, guests can explore the grounds, sculpture collection, and experience the magnificent view of the Youghiogheny River Gorge.

## GROUP TOURS

*Approx. 45 minutes. For groups of 10 or more.*

This is similar in content to the Regular House Tour (see above) for larger groups of ten or more.
