## Handcart Treks

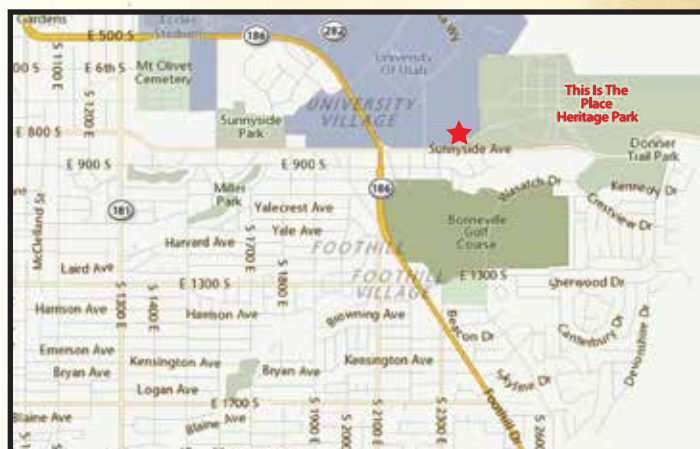
Trek in the same canyon as the pioneers. Learn to work and play like the early Utah settlers did. Snacks and food are included as you pull your handcarts.

**Celebrate the pioneer spirit and Native American culture with us.**  
**There is something for every person to see and do. Step back in time and experience the West as it was in the early settlement of Utah.**

**R**ide one of our four trains -- the 119, Jupiter, Blackhawk, or Betsy Jane, while touring the Park. Kids will love riding around the pond on the mini train, pony rides and visiting our farm animals. Don't forget to take a turn milking Clarabelle the Cow.



**T**he Treasure House is one of the Park's newest additions, where you can learn about Utah's rich mining history. Dig in the Prospector Pit for shiny, colorful gemstones, and crack a geode to discover the surprise inside.

**G**uests love panning for gold. There is no excitement quite like finding a shiny nugget hiding in the silt and sand. Climb and play on the Ship Brooklyn, a replica of the original ship, that represents the expedition of the pioneers, sailing from New York to San Francisco.



**I**nteract with a blacksmith, tinsmith, and saddle maker. Try your hand at some old-fashioned pioneer activities -- wash clothes on a washboard, learn the Deseret alphabet in the schoolhouse, get a shave from the barber, or print a card on our printing press. The streets come alive with music and dancing performed by our talented Heritage Singers. Don't miss the Irrigation Station splash pad where you can cool off on hot summer days.

**W**hen the pioneers settled this region, it was home to the Native American tribes. Watch traditional native dancing in our newly built teepee, climb sandstone rock walls, make an Indian craft, and enjoy storytelling in the Navajo hogan. The Medicine Wheel will teach you about the values of Native Americans.



**T**he ZCMI Candy and Toy Shop is filled with sweets from yesteryear and loads of old fashioned toys for kids. The Grill at the Huntsman Hotel is the place to go for hungry visitors. Next door there's an ice cream shop with soft serve flavor burst cones. Brigham's Donuts are cooked fresh daily -- follow your nose to a little bit of sugary heaven.

**V**isit the iconic This Is The Place Monument which represents the early pioneers, Native Americans, fur trappers, and traders. See monuments to the Pony Express and the Mormon Battalion. Visit the Walk of Pioneer Faiths honoring early religious groups and leaders who contributed to the diversity of our great community. Tour the Brigham Young Farmhouse and our rare collection of quilts and lace.
