By Car: Clayton West Station is situated on the A636 Wakefield to Denby Dale road, close to junctions 38 or 39 of the M1 motorway. Follow the brown tourist signs for Kirkstalls Light Railway. We are situated at the top of Park Mill Way, past the industrial estate and through the large white gates. Postcode for your sat nav: HD8 9XL.

By Train: The local railway station at Denby Dale is easily accessed by local buses. Wakefield and Huddersfield railway stations are also accessible by bus. A walking route between Denby Dale Station and Shelley Station is signposted by way markers. For National Rail enquiries, please visit www.nationalrail.co.uk or call 03457 48 49 50.

By Bus: Buses run regularly to Clayton West from Huddersfield, Wakefield and Holmfirth. Visit www.wymetro.com for timetables and journey planning information.

Please note there are no car parking facilities at Shelley Station.

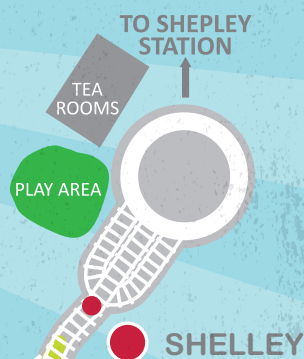
