This tour visits the mysterious village of Avebury which is ringed by the largest stone circle in the world! In total, it's home to 3 ancient stone circles and you'll have free time to wander among the stones of the inner circles and the great outer circle, and witness the enormity of the bank and ditch of Avebury Henge.

Whilst there, in your free time, why not also explore the famously haunted Red Lion pub? A pub packed full of history and has been featured on the TV show "Most Haunted". They serve a great British pub lunch too!

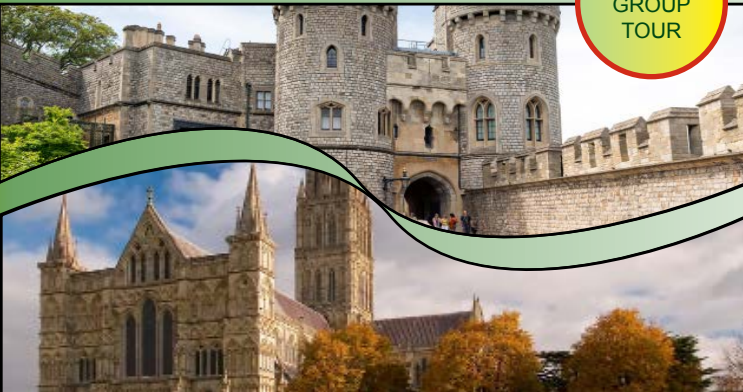
Windsor, Stonehenge & Salisbury from £65
