What is Coasteering?

Wriggle into a wetsuit, fasten up your adventure kit, listen to the safety briefing and you're ready to go. Your Guides will lead you along a stunning stretch of the Pembrokeshire Coast National Park.

Along the way you'll find yourself scramble climbing, adventure swimming, rock hopping and of course not forgetting cliff jumping with heights up to 35ft.

Who can Coasteer?

Minimum age is 8 years. You don't even need to be able to swim as your buoyancy aid will keep you afloat and your Guide will be close at hand. Small groups & individuals welcome.

How long does it last and when can I Coasteer?

Our sessions start at 9.30am and 2pm daily, all year round and in all weather conditions.

You'll be in the water for $2 - 2\frac{1}{2}$ hours, meeting on location gives you more time to play in the sea!



What do I need to bring?

You'll need to bring swimwear, a towel, an old pair of trainers (to get wet) and a pair of old shorts. We will provide all adventure equipment including wetsuit, buoyancy aid, helmet, gloves, hoods and socks.

Can I bring my camera?

Yes, however your Guide will carry a digital camera, capturing photos and videos as your adventure unfolds. This footage is available to purchase on the day.
