Dogs are not allowed within the centre grounds. However there are lots of dog walks in the surrounding woods and dogs are welcome in the car park area.

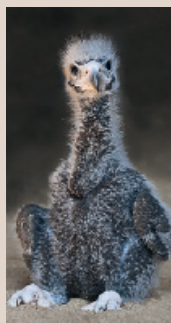
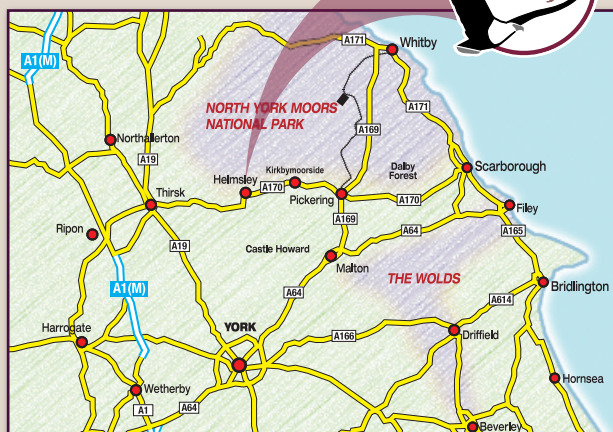
